Section Committees: The Health Care Law Section features a Substantive Law Committee with five subcommittees, consisting of the Medical Legal Subcommittee, Payors Subcommittee, Providers Subcommittee, Technology Subcommittee and the Legislative Update Subcommittee. These Substantive Law Subcommittees are responsible for organizing various educational programs, which are typically teleconferences, to benefit our membership. The Legislative Update subcommittee organizes our annual Legislative Update program, which provides our members with the "latest word" from the Michigan legislature and administrative agencies regarding health law issues. In addition, the Health Care Law Section has a Pro Bono Committee, a Technology Committee, an Annual Meeting Committee, a Publications Committee, a Nominating Committee, a New Lawyers and Law Students Committee, and a Council Fellows Exploration Committee. There are currently two task force/work group efforts underway: the HIPAA/HITECH work group and the Nightingale Task Force.

Legislative issues: None of note for the Section this year.

Recommendations for next Council: Continue to work to provide educational and networking resources to our membership, both via programs and written materials. Pursue the Section's support of the Michigan Pledge to Achieve Diversity and Inclusion. Continue efforts with the New Lawyers outreach.

Other Information: The Section once again hosted luncheon events this year at several Michigan law schools for the purpose of providing a forum for students to meet Section members and learn about the various opportunities for lawyers within the health care industry. The Section will again host a law student writing competition, the first and second place winners of which will be announced at the Annual Meeting in September. The Section again organized a team and participated in the Susan G. Komen Race for the Cure in Detroit on May 21, 2011. Our Publications Committee compiled and edited a "theme" edition of the SBM Bar Journal for June 2011. The Section voted to sign the State Bar of Michigan's Michigan Pledge to Support Diversity and Inclusion. The Section voted to send the incoming Chair to the State Bar Leadership Forum held annually. The Section also is exploring the possibility of an honorary "fellows" designation for members who have exemplary service.
