This Act permits Advanced Practice Registered Nurses ("APRN") to provide specified medical services without physician delegation and supervision, although the prescribing of controlled substances continues to require physician delegation and supervision. Public Act 379 of 2016, effective March 22, 2017, revises the relationship between Physician Assistants ("PA") and physicians. A PA will be required to practice according to the terms of a compliant written practice agreement between the PA and the physician.
