**OPINION AND ORDER**

This matter is before the Court on Defendants' motion for summary disposition brought pursuant to MCR 2.116(C)(8), which is unopposed. For the reasons set forth below, Defendants' motion for summary disposition is GRANTED.

"A motion for summary disposition under MCR 2.116(C)(8) tests the legal sufficiency of the claim on the basis of the pleadings alone[.]" *Bailey v Schaaf*, 494 Mich 595, 603; 835 NW2d 413 (2013). "The motion must be granted if no factual development could justify the plaintiff's claim for relief." *Id.*, quoting *Spiek v Mich Dep't of Transp*, 456 Mich 331, 337; 572 NW2d 201 (1998). Defendants argue that Plaintiff's complaint is unintelligible and as such fails to state a claim upon which relief could be granted. This Court's review of Plaintiff's complaint reveals that the Defendants are correct. As such, granting summary disposition in favor of the Defendants is appropriate. MCR 2.116(C)(8).

This disposes of the last pending claim and closes the case.
