**ORDER REGARDING DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR
CLARIFICATION**

At a session of said Court held in,
Detroit, Wayne, Michigan, on

Defendant having filed a motion for reconsideration or clarification of this Court's 9/7/2017 Opinion and Order;


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that defendant's motion is GRANTED IN PART to the extent that this Court did not rule upon defendant's alternative request for a more definite statement. Within 14 days of this order, plaintiff shall file an amended complaint containing a more definite statement concerning the parameters of its exemption claim, consistent with this Court's September 7, 2017 opinion.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the last sentence of the paragraph beginning on page 8 of this Court's opinion and concluding on page 9 is amended to read as follows: "In other words, Plaintiff's exempt use of the subject equipment did not begin until the moment that the physically severed building components began moving for industrial processing purposes, and plaintiff's exempt use ended when the finished goods first came to rest in finished goods storage inventory."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Expert witnesses must be named no later than November 3, 2017.
2. All other witnesses must be named no later than November 10, 2017.
3. Discovery shall be completed on or before December 22, 2017.

4. This matter shall be submitted to mediation with Hon. Mary Beth Kelly. Mediation shall be completed on or before February 2, 2018, or upon recommendation by the mediator, such deadline may be extended.
