

# Rules of Golf

## Hazards:

**There are three kinds of hazards:**

**Bunkers:** Sand filled depressions

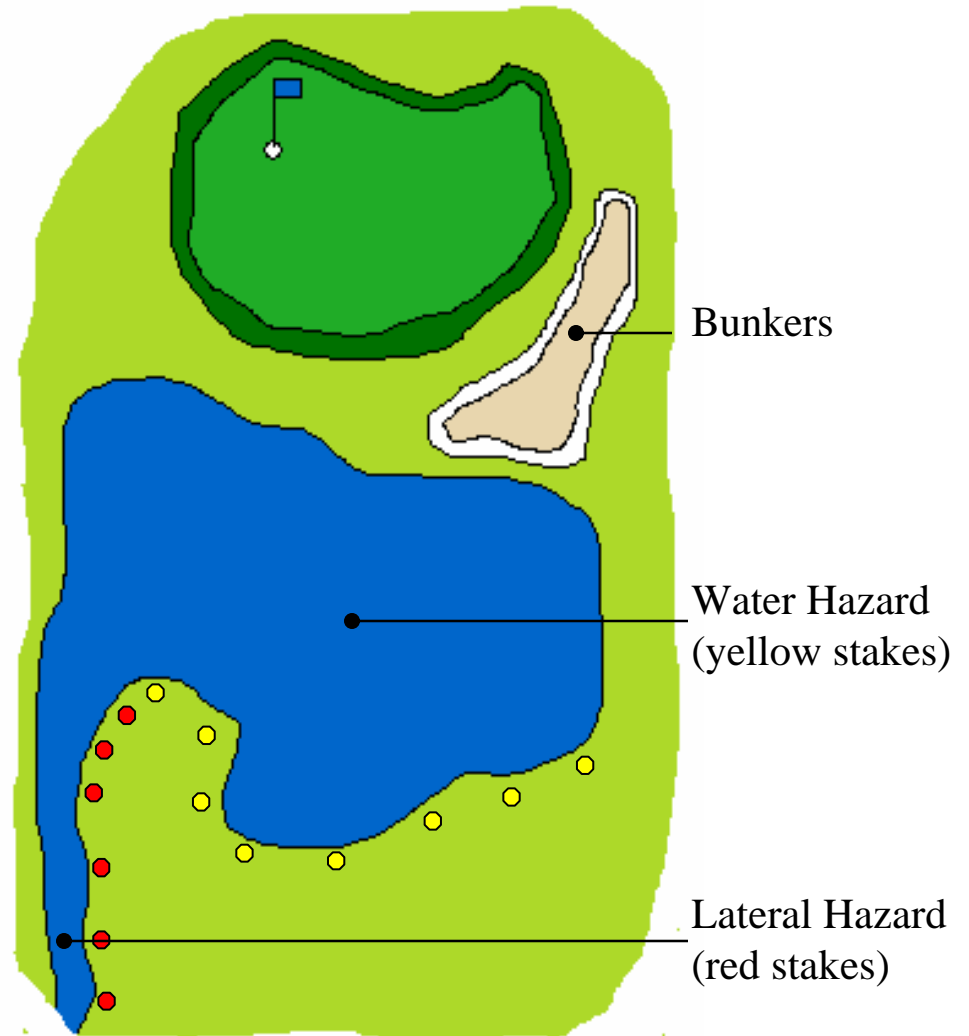
**Water Hazards:** A waterway (not necessarily with water) on the course that is marked by yellow stakes.

**Lateral Water Hazards:** A type of water hazard that runs roughly along the direction of play and is marked with red stakes.

**All hazards have certain things in common**

1. You are not allowed to test the surface inside the hazard with your hand or club (this means you're not to ground your club in a hazard)
2. You are not allowed to move or disturb anything in the hazard.

**Penalty for doing either: 2 Strokes**
