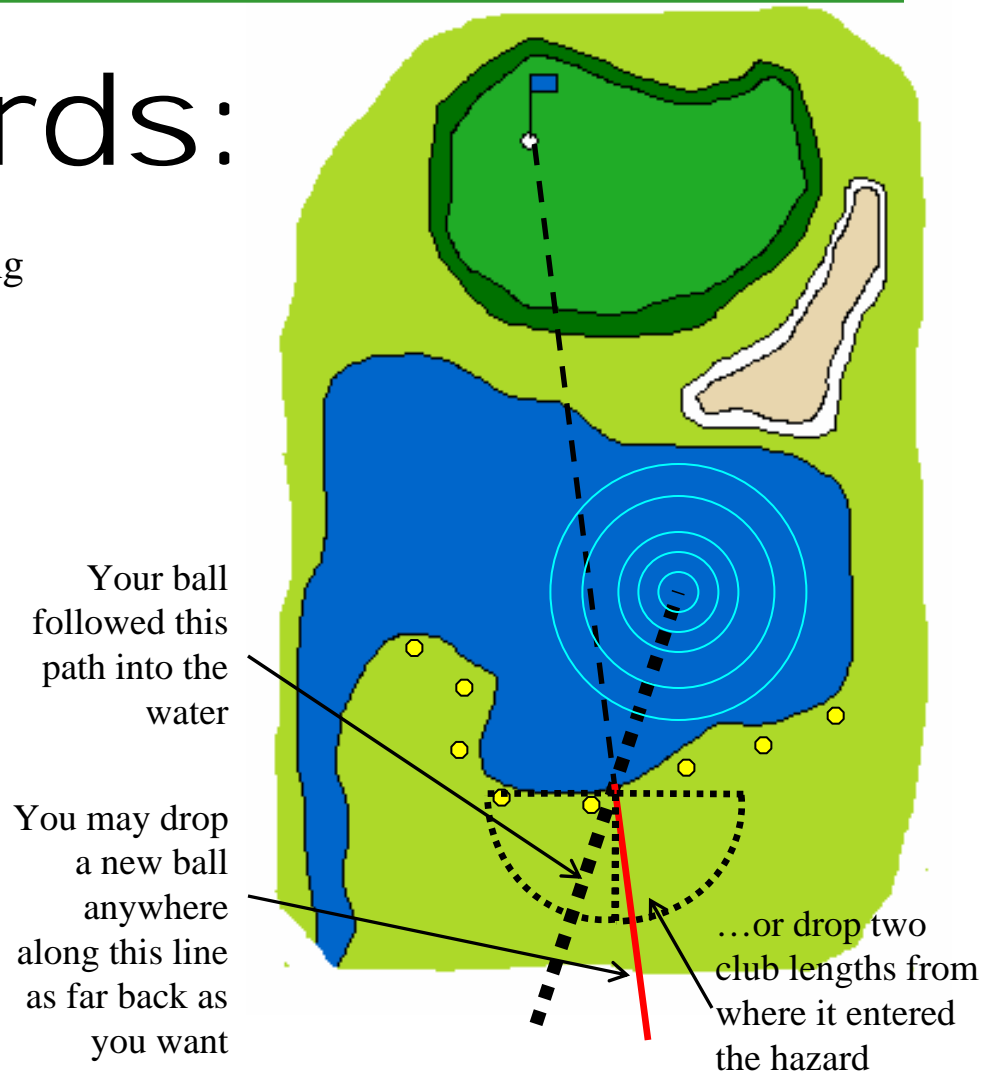


Rules of Golf

Water Hazards:

- Water Hazards are marked by yellow stakes. The hazard is not just the water – it's everything inside the yellow stakes.
- If your ball is in the hazard, but you can hit it, you can play the ball without penalty.
- If your ball is lost in the water (e.g. in the water), take a **one stroke penalty**, then:
 - Go back to where you originally hit the ball and play a new ball, or...
 - Drop a new ball anywhere behind the hazard along the line from the hole to where the ball entered the hazard, or...
 - Drop a new ball within two club lengths of where the ball entered the hazard, no closer to the hole.
