

Rules of Golf



Teeing Off:

You can tee off anywhere between the tee markers to a depth of two club lengths. Only the ball must be within this area. You can stand outside if you wish.

Penalty for teeing off outside the “teeing ground”: Two strokes plus you must play the shot over.



Order of Play:

Who tees off first?

The player with honors i.e. the player with the lowest score on the previous hole.

Who tees off first on the first hole?

Determined by lot – traditional way is to flip a tee. The one it points to when it lands tees off first.



In Stroke Play there is no penalty for playing out of order. In Match Play your opponent may require you to replay the stroke.

Note: We play “Ready Golf” – first one to the tee box with a club and ball tees off first.
