

Rules of Golf

Putting

- Before you make your putt, you are *not* to test the surface determine the speed of the greens by rolling a ball or scraping it or any other way that gives you such feedback.
- You may brush loose impediments from the line of your putt.
- You may lift and clean your ball when it is on the green. Be sure to mark it first. (Always mark first, then lift.)
- There is no penalty for accidentally moving your mark. Just put it back as closely to the original spot as possible.
