



Obtaining a USGA Handicap through EWGA's GN21 Handicap System

Your account is automatically set up in the GN21 handicap system so all you need to do is login. Please follow the directions below to access. For any login issues, please send an email to handicap@myewga.com for further assistance.

1. Go to www.EWGA.com.
2. From the EWGA Homepage, click on Member Login in the upper right corner or Member Clubhouse on the left side.
3. Enter your primary email address that is on file with EWGA.
For the first login, your password will be Password1 with a cap on the "P".
4. Click on GO. *(you will be prompted to change your password at this time)*
5. Click on HANDICAP on the left side, and you will be automatically directed to your GN21 home page
6. To post scores, click on Enter Score on the right side.
*Since this is your first time for posting scores, please select the **Away Course Finder** tool bar in **RED**.*
7. Search for the course by state, then select from the pull down menu. This will bring up all the courses listed in your state, which can be changed for out-of-state courses.
8. Select your course of play and complete the following
 - a. Date your round was played
 - b. Number of holes played – 9 (front or back) or 18
 - c. Name of Tee from which you played
 - d. Course rating will automatically populate, however double check with your scorecard
 - e. Type in your Adjusted Gross Score
9. Click on POST – *you will be directed to an area to confirm this post*
10. After posting you will be able to view your Scoring Record.

The course you selected will automatically appear in your own course list for future posting. A minimum of five (5) 18-hole rounds or its equivalent, i.e. ten (10) 9-hole rounds, are required before the next revision date to generate an official USGA handicap index. Handicap revision dates occur on the 1st & 15th of each month.
