PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Our new look!

Our biggest desire is to publish an attractive, user-friendly newsletter that helps you get the most out of your LPGA Women Who Play membership. Half of our membership responded to the May survey regarding Chapter communication. We learned a lot and you will notice a few changes in the format of the newsletter as a result:

- Rules of Golf rated high as the most often read section. For your ease, this will now be found on page 2.
- Survey respondents reported the newsletter and the website are most often used for accessing the calendar of events. As a result, page 3 now has the entire list of events and the rsvp link for the current month.
- For your convenience, course discounts are listed on page 4.

We also learned Just Around the Corner and Time Sensitive event specific emails are highly valued. Just Around the Corner is typically sent around the 15th of the month. Time Sensitive emails typically pertain to an upcoming social event and are sent a week to two weeks prior to the event.

Thank you to all that responded to the call for volunteers! We did have an OOPS! with that section of the survey monkey. There was no way to figure out who volunteered for what. If you volunteered for one or more of the volunteer opportunities below, please email me at ewgaco@gmail.com.

- Track social event participation stats: This involves tracking attendance of members on an excel spread sheet. Time involved: monthly one-hour max after an event. (2 responded)
- Contact members that have not attended golf or social events for two months: The board will send you up to 5 names to call. This is an opportunity to check-in with members and invite them to an upcoming event. Time involved: monthly one-hour max. (8 responded)
- Newsletter editor: Computer skills needed. The board provides the articles and the editor does the layout and formatting. Time involved: 10-12

hours per month. (0 responded)

- Social secretary: Send members thinking of you, sympathy, get well, etc. cards as needed. Time involved: On an as needed basis. (0 responded)
- Website assistance: Work with the Communication Director to keep the website updated. Time involved: 5 to 7 hours a month. (1 responded)
- Social and recruitment monthly events: If you like planning a party, this is for you! Time involved: One to two hours for the event you choose to help with. (5 responded)
- Track new or existing member profile: This involves entering member profile data so that we can better serve our members. Time involved: Initially more time upfront will be required because this is a new project and 50 members need to be entered. The goal is to have this completed by July. After July, the time required is on an as needed basis as new members join. (1 responded)
- Provide reminder calls to members to renew their membership: This is another opportunity to check-in with members. Time involved: On an as needed basis and could be up to one hour a month. (3 responded)

ETIQUETTE: GOLF COURSE DRESS CODES

Ask a Lawyer...about the Rules of Golf

Last season I wrote a column about dressing for success on the golf course, and with the weather turning warmer, it's time for us all to go through our golf wardrobe and see what we should add in this year. Compared to the clothing in a lot of other sports, ladies' golf clothes are generally reasonably priced. We spend a lot of money on our clubs and on green fees. It makes sense to treat yourself every once in a while and pick up a new top or bottom, a hat, maybe a few new gloves for the season, and definitely a new pair of golf shoes each year or so. With the change over from EWGA to LPGA, there will be another opportunity for new golf clothes. I have about five EWGA golf shirts that needed to be retired anyway, so now I am waiting for the LPGA Women Who Play main website to have it's "shopping" link up and running.

Some of the golf courses in Central Oregon are lax on their dress code. But most are fairly traditional, and have standard requirements. For example, a couple of weeks ago I was fortunate to play golf at Brasada with some friends, and I noticed the course includes a copy of its dress code in their tee time confirmation:

Dress Code - We ask that all golfers wear appropriate golf attire throughout the entire golf course facility. A collared shirt, non-denim slack or short, and soft spike golf shoes. Denim and athletic wear is not considered appropriate attire at Brasada Canyons.

In fact, most of the golf courses we play at have a similar dress code. I have seen people (not our members) decked out in T-Shirts and jeans ask about a dress code when they check in for their tee time at the Pro Shop. Lots of times, the Pro Shop will just shrug and tell the golfer they are fine. The golf course may just be happy for the business, or they don't want to embarrass the golfer.

In addition to the LPGA Women Who Play website, many of our chapter's sponsors have great golf clothing and gear for women. Take a look at your Golf Passport to learn who our sponsors are, and thank them by wearing one of their tops or hats next time you golf there!
