

Member Privacy vs Required Contact Information

- More and more EWGA members are concerned about having their personal contact information appear online. We respect that and have a couple of options for you to have control of what you want to appear.
- The option of marking your record in the EWGA database as “Do Not Publish Online” is available, however it has negative consequences. If this is done to a member record, then the member is blocked from being able to login to the EWGA Member Clubhouse and the Handicap Service. We do not recommend this option.
- Some members have gone online and deleted their mailing address, phone and email so that it won't appear online. We definitely do not recommend this option as then there is no way to communicate with you at all.
- The best option is for you to login to the Member Clubhouse (www.myewga.com) and update the “Privacy Settings” under the “My Profile” tab. You can choose specifically which information you want to show online, and to whom (Including nobody).
