



The EWGA Championship is now in its 22nd year as the largest women's amateur golf competition in the world and we want YOU to be a part of the fun and excitement. Members of **all skill levels** are encouraged to compete so give the Championship a try and put your game to the test!

HOW DOES THE CHAMPIONSHIP WORK?

The EWGA Championship offers two different formats: Stroke Play (individual play in flights designated by handicap) and Team Scramble (4-person teams). You select the format that best fits your game, personality and skill level.

There are three stages of the Championship. Two winners from each stroke play flight and the two winning scramble teams advance to the next stage.

- 1) The Chapter Championship, an 18-hole local qualifying round held at each Chapter location
- 2) The Semi-Final Championship, an 18-hole round held at 15 venues from June – August
- 3) The EWGA Championship Finals, a two-day, 36 hole event held on October 6-7, 2017

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO TO PLAY?

- Be a female, EWGA member in good standing
- Have a verifiable USGA Handicap Index and have an equivalent of two 18-hole scores posted to your handicap record in the current year **no later than June 14th**.
- Be a female amateur golfer as defined by USGA Rules of Amateur Status and EWGA gender policy
- Follow the registration guidelines distributed by our Chapter and register on time. **There are absolutely no exceptions to the deadline.**

CHAMPIONSHIP ELEMENTS...

HQ Entry fee of \$50 is required to participate in the EWGA Championship. Columbus Chapter fee to play in the 18-hole qualifying tournament is \$39 (includes range balls, cart, green fee, food at awards). Total due at registration: \$89.

Registration information for the Ohio Valley Semi-Final Championship will be provided at the Chapter Championship to all competitors eligible to advance.

NOW WHAT?

Establish your handicap index OR make sure your index is current no later than June 14th. Here's how:

- Establish a handicap index: play and post five 18-hole scores or ten 9-hole scores to the EWGA (or other) handicap system by June 14th.
- Current index: play and post at least two 18-hole scores or four 9-hole scores to the handicap system during the current 2017 season by June 14th.

Decide whether you want to play as an individual or part of a scramble team. If it's team play – find 3 other Chapter members and make a team.

Register for the July 8th Championship at Cooks Creek **no later than Wednesday, June 21st at 3:00 pm** www.ewgachampionship.com/chapterchampionships. Log in and select Columbus under the Ohio Valley District.
