- **[Marketing Director](#)** (two-year term). Combines member recruitment with external promotion, coordinating with the Membership Director and Communications Director.
- **[Golf & Special Events Director](#)** (two-year term). Manages individual golf events such as the PlayARound series, coordinating with the existing golf post newly reconfigured as Golf Leagues & Education Director.
- **[Social Events Director](#)** (two-year term). Continues to run non-golf events including Happy Hours, Spring Kick-Off, and Annual Dinner.

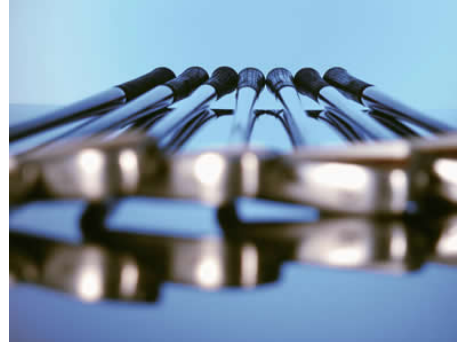
