When will monetary awards be distributed?

Monetary awards are mailed before the start date of each semester in which the scholarship is awarded. Each recipient is required to provide proof of enrollment for each award semester before the monetary award is mailed. Please be advised that it may take several weeks to receive the award once proof of enrollment is received. It is important to make plans around tuition accordingly.

What is proof of enrollment?

Every scholarship recipient is required to show proof that they will be matriculating as a full-time student for the award semester(s). The same applies to those scholars enrolled in graduate school. Proof of enrollment can take the form of a letter from the registrar or receipt/confirmation of your online registration from your school. It must include your name, listing of courses for the fall semester, and an indication that it is from your school's official website.

Are scholarship awards made payable to the student or the school?

Awards are made payable to the scholarship recipient unless otherwise requested. Awardees will be sent a Scholarship Award Notice which should be used to indicate where the check should be mailed. If you change your residency before receiving your funds, please notify the NABA South Florida Student Member Services (SMS) Committee (students@nabamiami.org).

Are all NABA South Florida Scholarship recipients expected to attend the Awards Reception?

Yes. While, allowance will be made for extenuating circumstances, scholarship recipients should attend the Awards Reception.
