Oliver Moghissi Award

The NACE Institute's Oliver Moghissi Award recognizes an individual who has demonstrated exemplary support of the corrosion control community through work that bridges the gap between corrosion maintenance/operations activities and the use of business-oriented corrosion management systems in industry.

Successful nominees will have:

- I. Demonstrated longstanding contributions resulting in industry-recognized products, services, standards, or similar resources that will increase asset life cycles by bridging the gap between technical management and business management, and
- II. Led industry(ies) to have an increased focus on business-centered corrosion management strategies by asset owner organizations, for the purpose of increasing asset sustainability, optimizing efficiency, and increasing safety, and
- III. Enhanced awareness, outside of the corrosion control industry, of the importance of the corrosion control industry.

The work of candidates who receive this award must be worthy of an award named after Oliver Moghissi. To be exemplary, the contributions must be conspicuous, meritorious, and broadly impactful. Industry-focused contributions are sought as opposed to committee leadership activities. Technical performance or achievement have no bearing on the award. Such information should not be included in the nomination and could detract from the nominee's consideration.

The nomination must include a thorough and detailed statement that substantiates how the nominee fulfills the criteria included herein. Nominations that describe a person's contributions to an industry by virtue of a committee role will not fulfill the criteria.
