Meeting will be held at the Holiday Inn, Melbourne, and will include a Technical Presentation “Powerlines, Pipelines, Railways, and Increasing complexity of Common Right of ways. How our ever-changing environment affects buried infrastructure.” by Mr. Aaron Raath, CEO at Cathtect USA Inc. **Key takeaways include the following:**

- As demand for energy, transportation, and connectivity accelerates, shared corridors are becoming increasingly complex. These common rights-of-way (ROWs) are no longer static utility pathways; they are dynamic systems shaped by expanding infrastructure needs, evolving regulations, and a rapidly changing environment.
- Exploring how the convergence of multiple infrastructure systems within constrained corridors introduces new challenges, focusing on buried infrastructure and how they are affected by above surface activity and subsurface interactions.
- What environmental conditions & infrastructure impact the integrity and performance of buried assets, examining emerging approaches to assessing, monitoring, modeling, and mitigating these risks.
- A deeper understanding of how to design, maintain, and protect buried infrastructure within increasingly crowded and environmentally stressed rights-of-way, by highlighting real-world challenges and forward-looking strategies.
