Educator Award in honor of Herbert Uhlig

Award Description:

This award is given to an academic educator for commitment to educational excellence at the undergraduate or graduate level. It recognizes outstanding and innovative effectiveness in academic post-secondary education at the graduate or undergraduate level in the broad fields of material protection and performance. Outstanding and innovative effectiveness must be demonstrated in the nomination. Contributions must go beyond holding lectures, running laboratory classes, or supervising student theses work. Related activities, such as publications, industry projects, etc. will also be considered in the broader context of the applicant's impact. Nominations will be considered for early or mid-career educators at an academic institution up to 10 years since the commencement of their career as an educator.

Members of AMPP and AMPP Global Center Boards of Directors, members of the Awards Committee, Awards Task Forces chairs: Eligible for nomination only after their terms in the respective bodies.

Past Recipients: Past recipients are not eligible for nomination for the same or similar (from legacy NACE or SSPC) AMPP award.

One Award per Year: A nominee is only eligible to receive one (1) award each calendar year. However, an individual may receive the Fellow Honor in addition to any other award in the same year.
