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Standards Committees (SCs)

- Responsible for developing, maintaining, and publishing all standards and standards-related products within their scope
- Established and approved by the AMPP Standards Program Committee (SPC)

SC Member Roles and Responsibilities

SC Member Roles and Responsibilities

There are two types of roles for SC members: Observer and Voting Member. These roles are further designated by three different interest classifications:

- **Producer:** technical views are drawn from an organization that produces or sells materials, products, systems, or services.
- **User:** technical views are drawn from an organization that purchases or are end user of materials, products systems, or services, other than for household use and would not also be classified as a Producer.
- **General Interest:** technical views are drawn from an organization that cannot be classified as either a Producer or a User.

Note: Individual Consultants must disclose if they are retained by a company in an area of technology being covered by the committee and shall be considered employed by the company for the purposes of interest classification

Both roles have similar responsibilities, but there are some key differences.

Participation on Standards Projects	Optional but recommended	Optional but recommended
Included on Communication Distribution	√	√
Voting on Standards	X	√

SC Member Roles and Responsibilities

Additionally, both Observers and Voting Members are eligible to:

- Propose new standards, guides, or reports projects
- Receive adjudication of comments on any ballot that is submitted to the SC
- Offer presentations providing information pertaining to the development of standards, guides, or reports

SC Member Roles and Responsibilities – Voting Members

Voting Member participation requirements to maintain voting membership status:

- Vote on all ballots submitted to the SC. Voter participation is tallied to determine if a ballot passes or fails
 - If the standard or report is outside your area of expertise, abstentions are counted!
 - If three consecutive ballots are missed, you may be reassigned as an Observer
- Attend SC meetings
 - If three consecutive SC meetings are missed, you may be reassigned as an Observer. Virtual attendance counts toward participation.

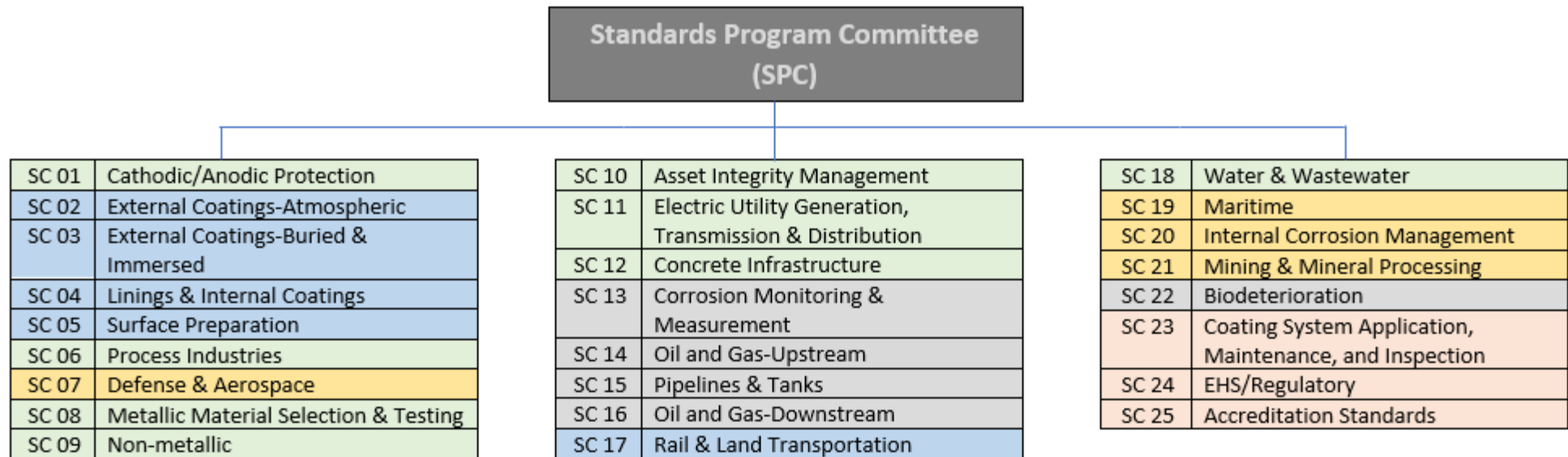
SC Presentations
