Chair-Elect

The year of service as Chair-Elect on the NANNP Council provides an opportunity to view and become knowledgeable about the membership division before assuming responsibility as chair. During this time, the Chair-Elect with support from the current chair and staff should also become familiar with the policies and strategic plan of the national association, NANN, as he/she will also become an official member of the NANN Board of Directors.

Eligibility Criteria

The Chair-Elect must have served at least one year on the NANNP Council.

Term

The Chair-Elect shall serve for 1 year, which will occur in the second year of his/her 2-year term on the NANNP council. The Chair-Elect will succeed to the position of Chair for 2 years and will be ineligible for re-election. The Chair-Elect will then serve 1 year as Immediate-Past-Chair.

Chair-Elect's Responsibilities:

- Act in the chair's stead in the absence of the chair.
- Appoint a NANNP member to serve on the NANN program planning committee during his/her term as chair.
- Recruit committee, and task force chairs, committee members, and liaisons to serve during his/her chairmanship.
- Prepare agenda for post conference council meeting.
