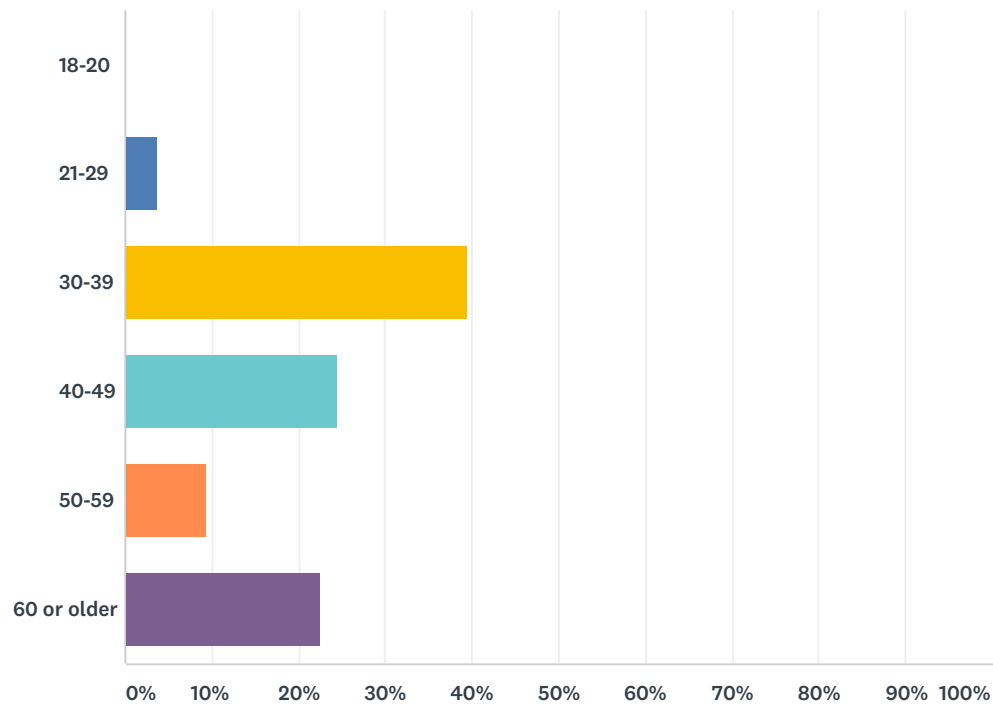

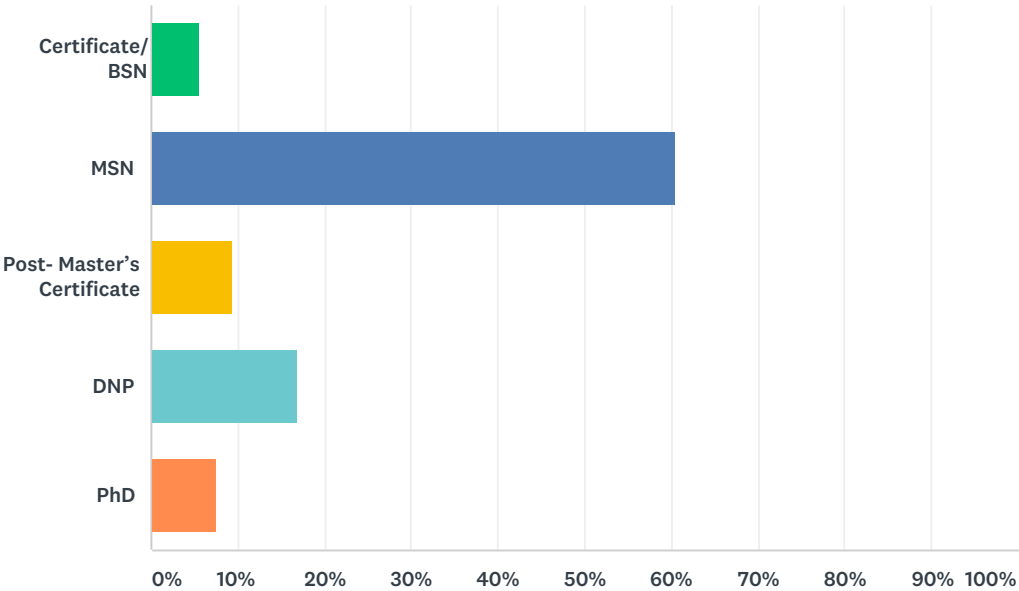

Q2 Highest Education level

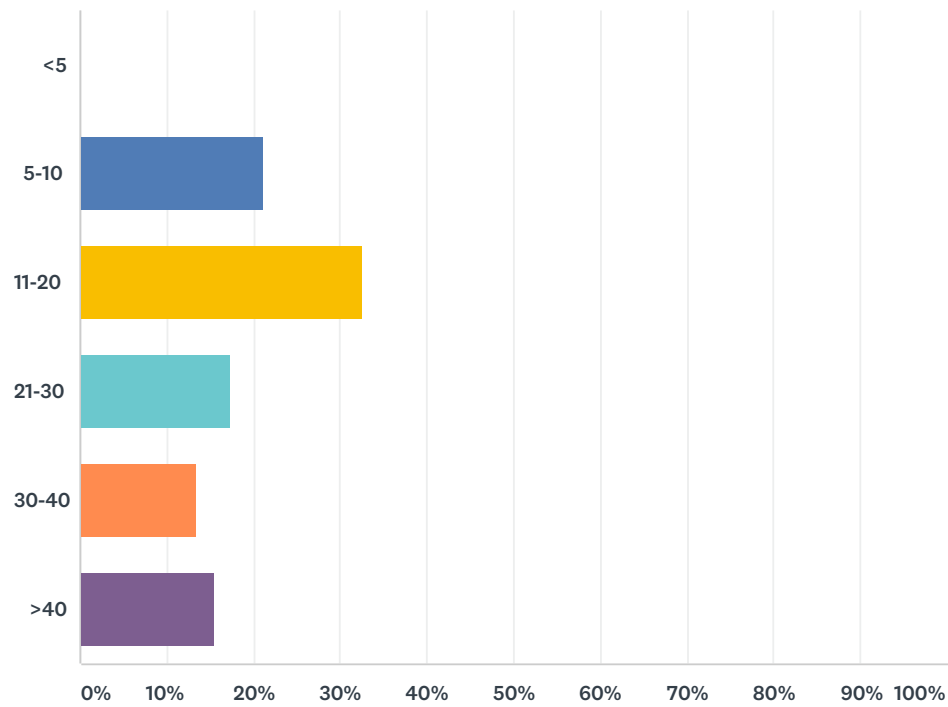

Q3 Years as an RN

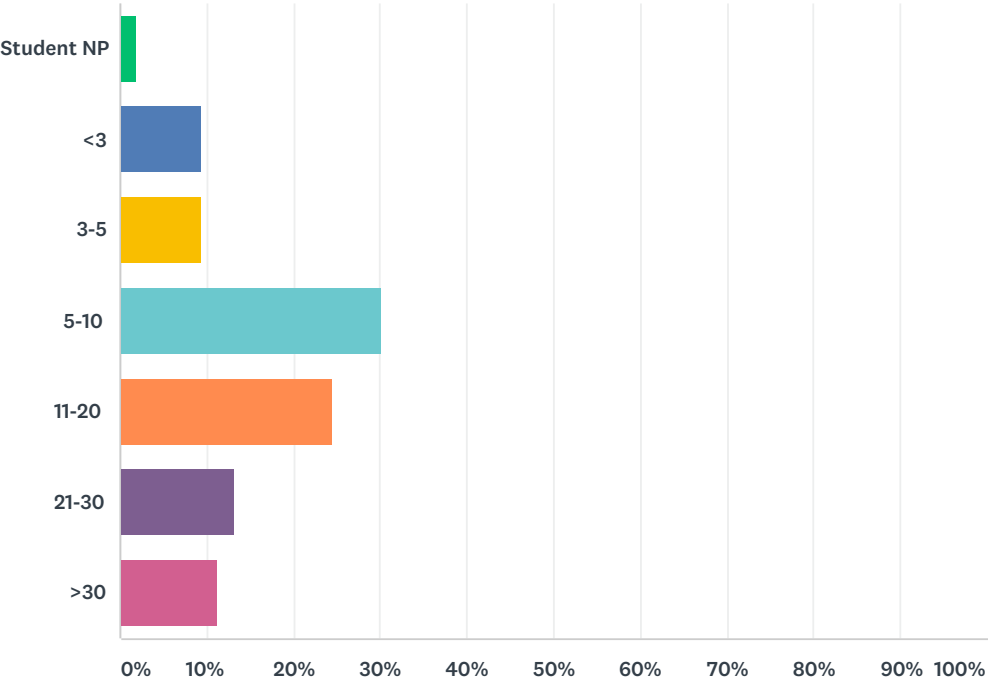

Q4 Years as Nurse Practitioner

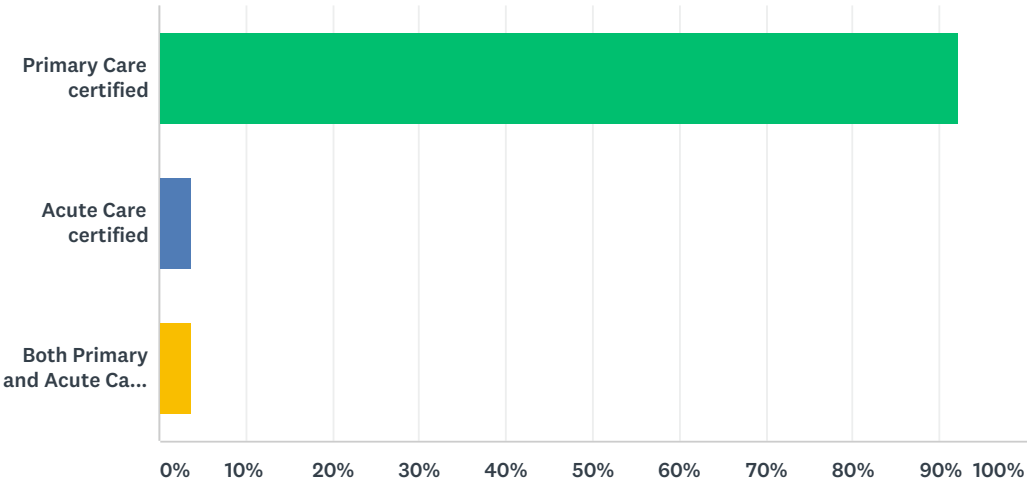

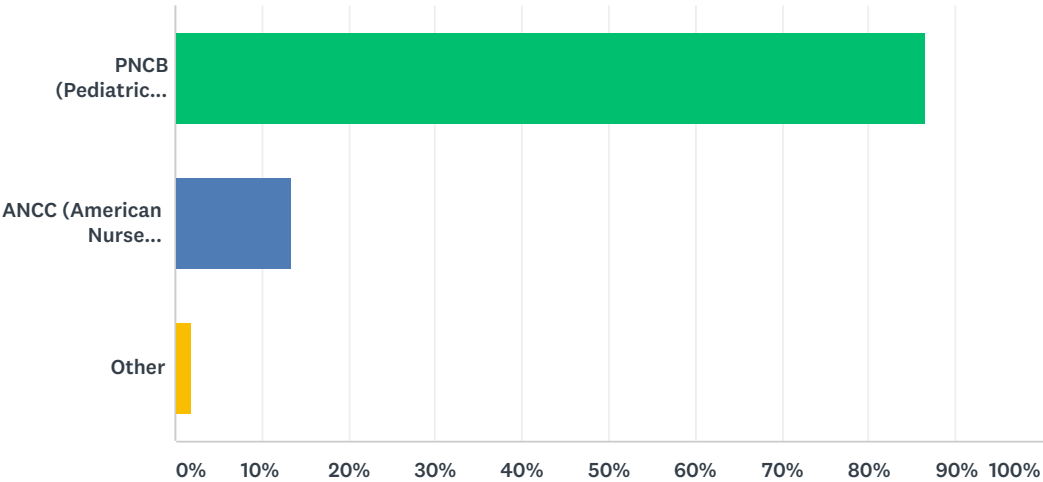

Q6 Who is your Certifying Agency?

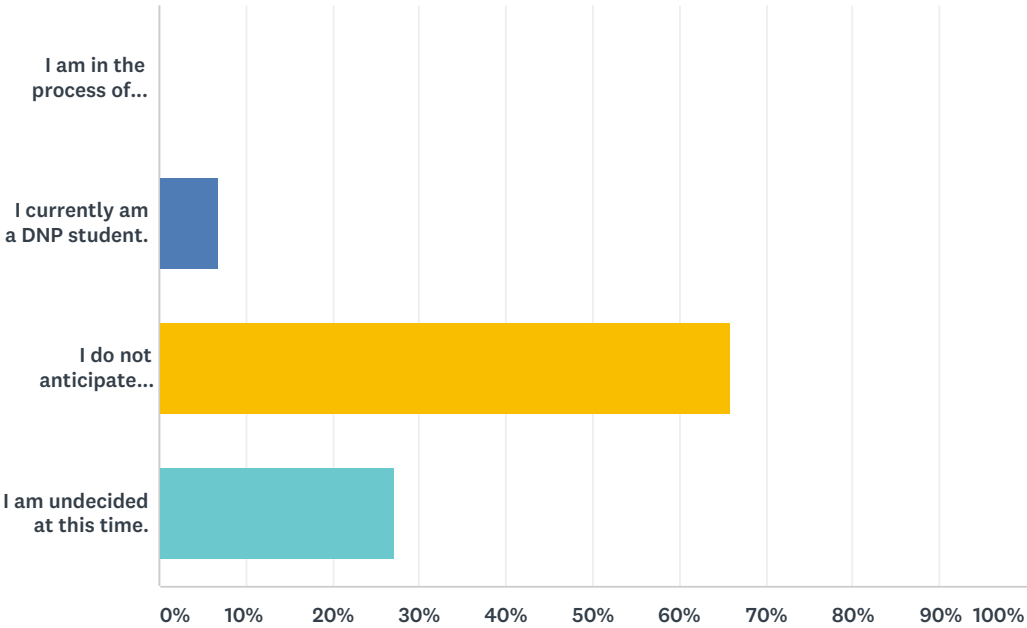

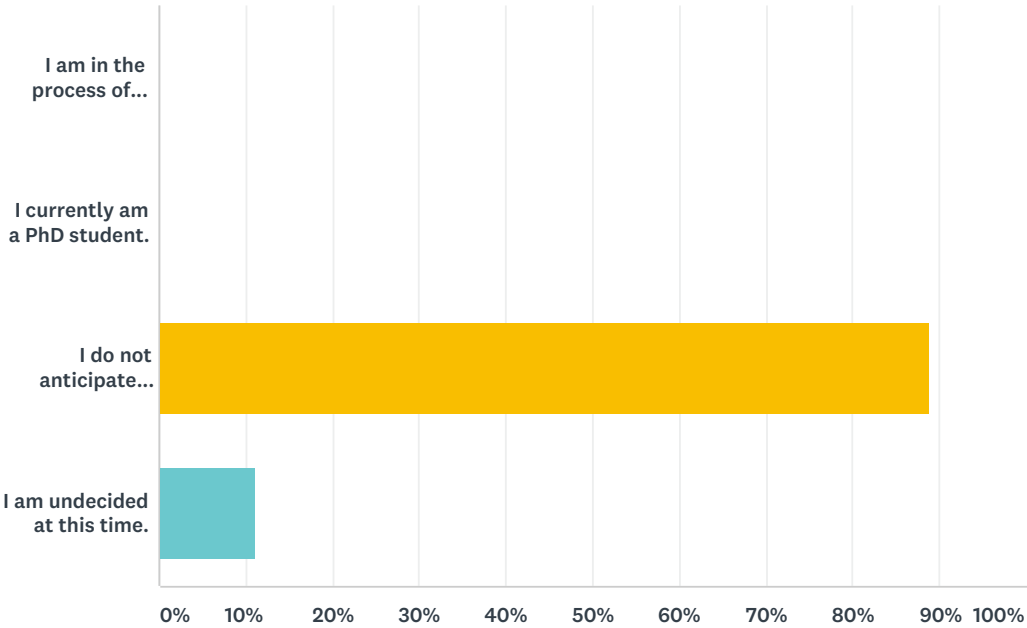

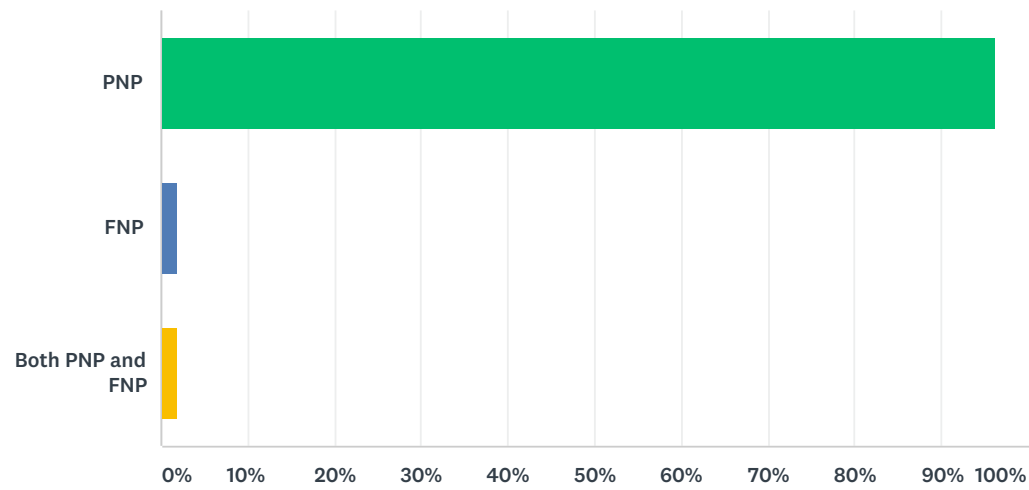

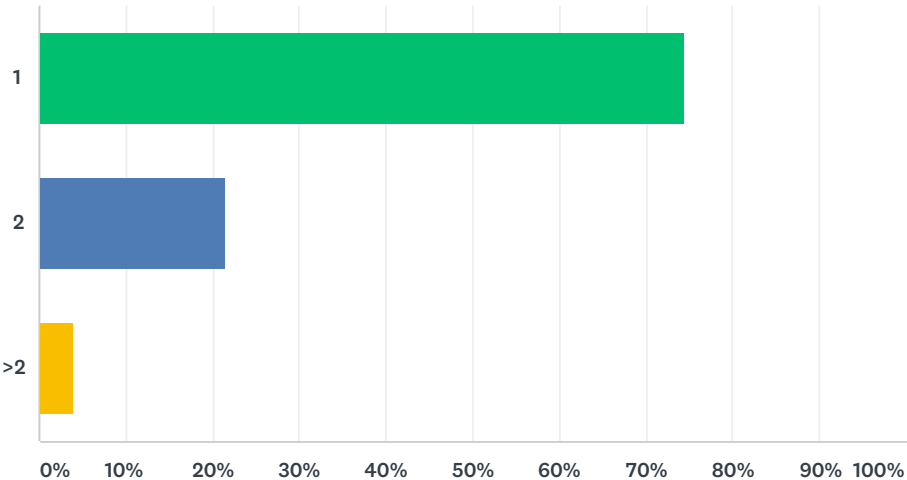

Q10 How many employment positions do you hold? (For all future questions, please select the best option for what you consider your PRIMARY position)

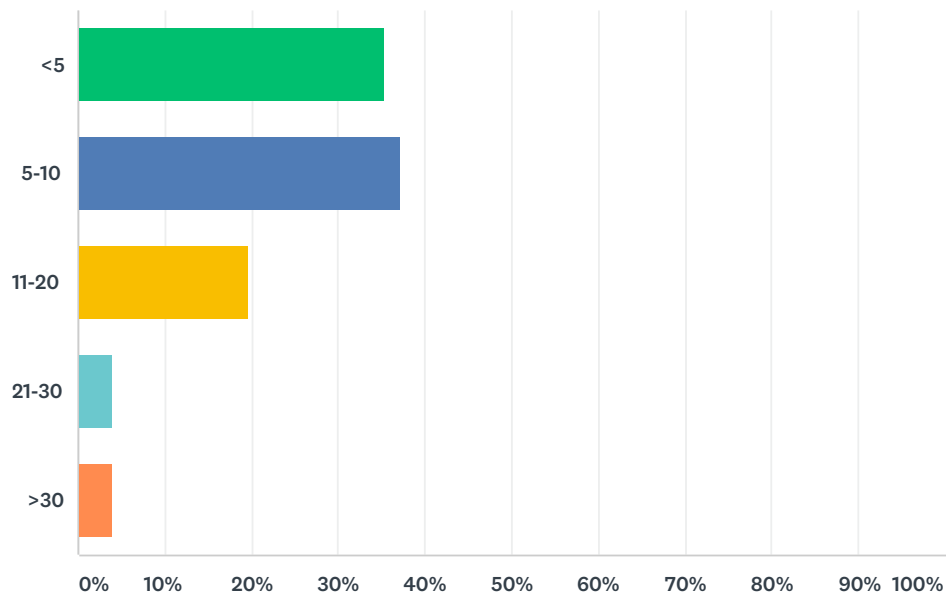

Q11 Years in current position

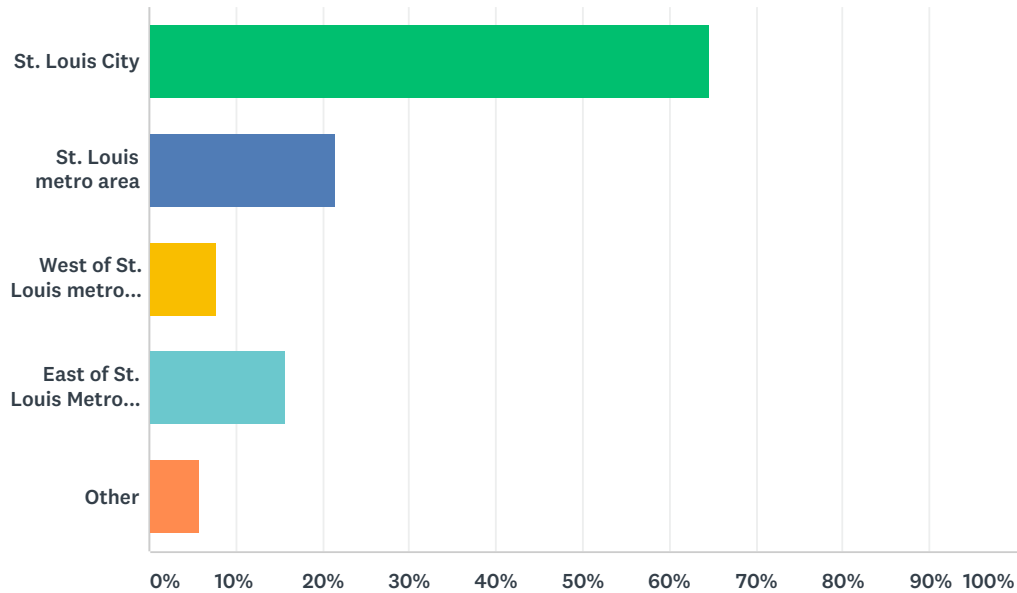

Q12 Location of practice (choose up to two choices if you work in more than one location for your primary position)

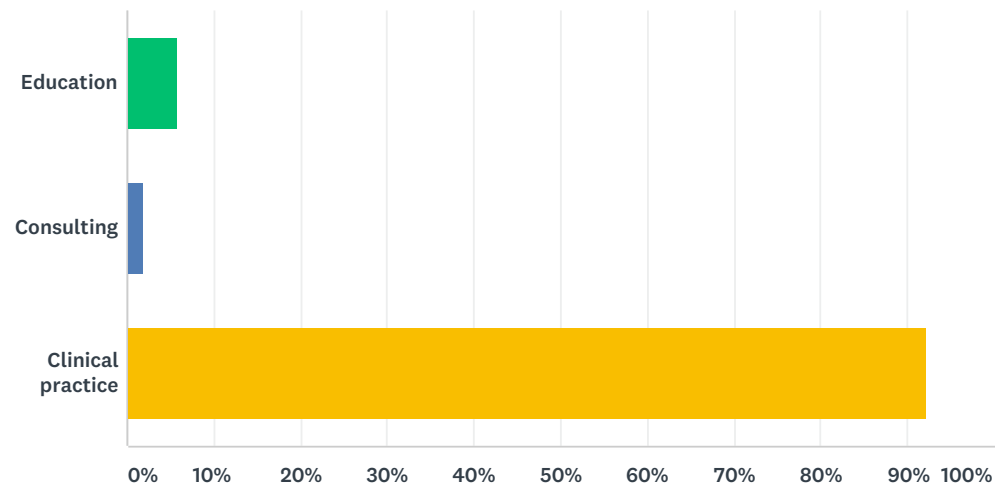

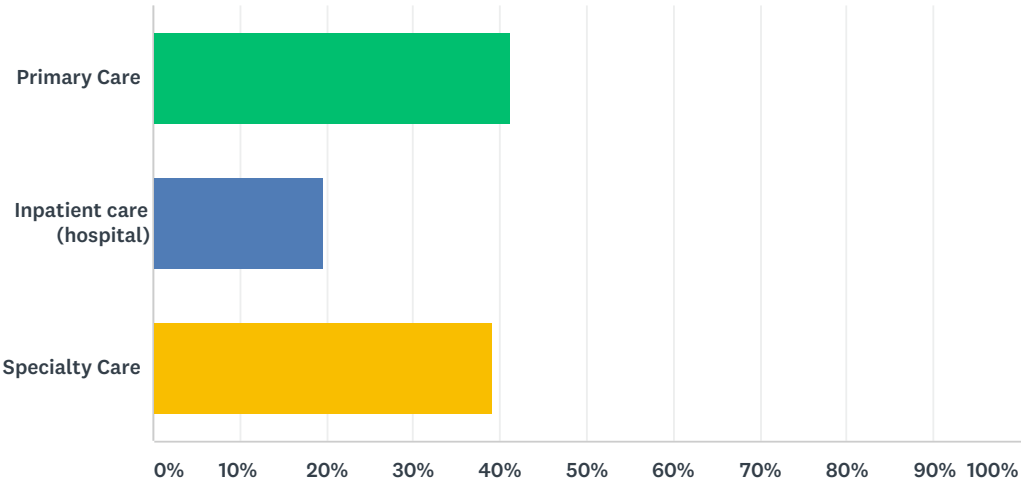

Q14 Area of clinical specialty

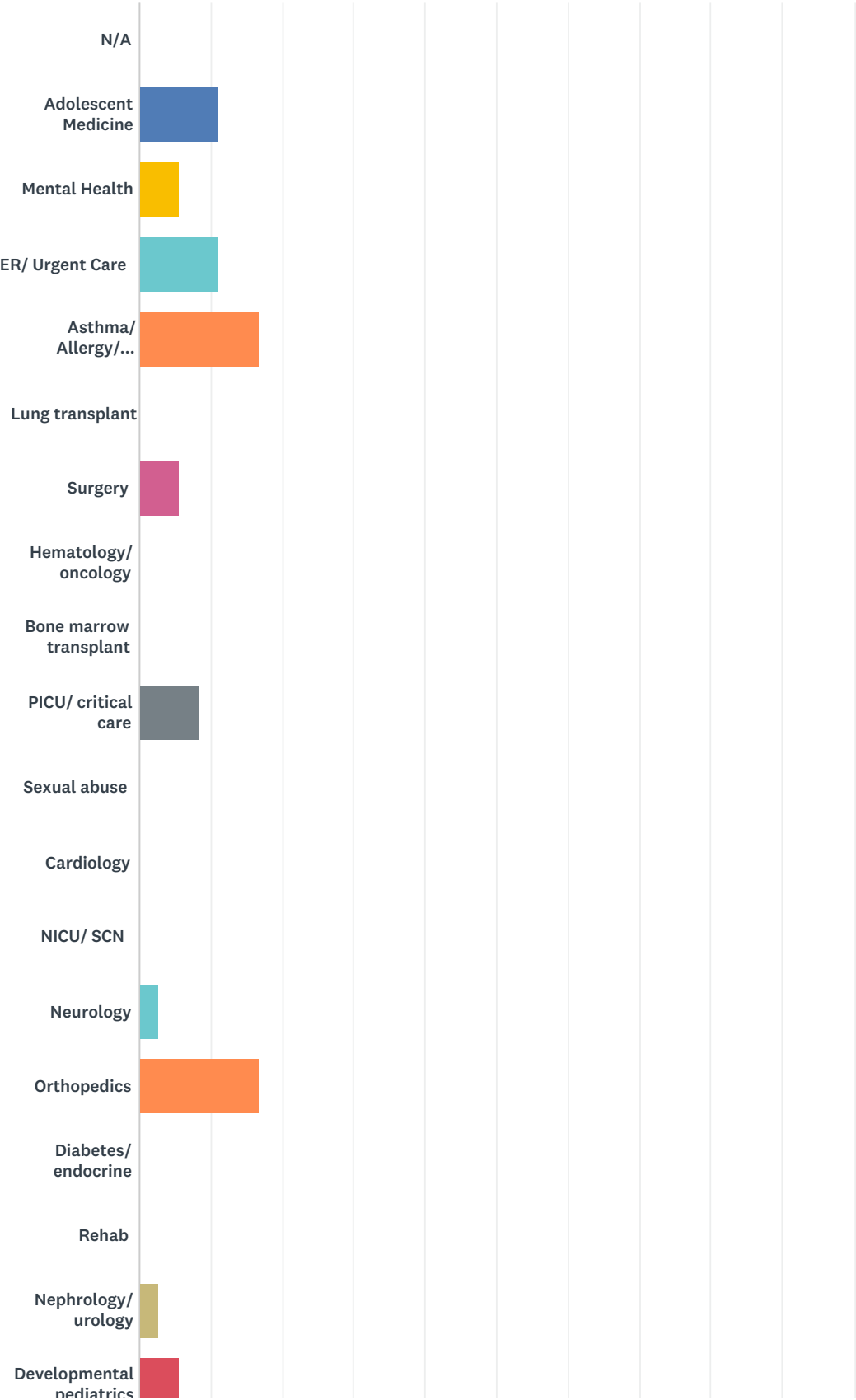

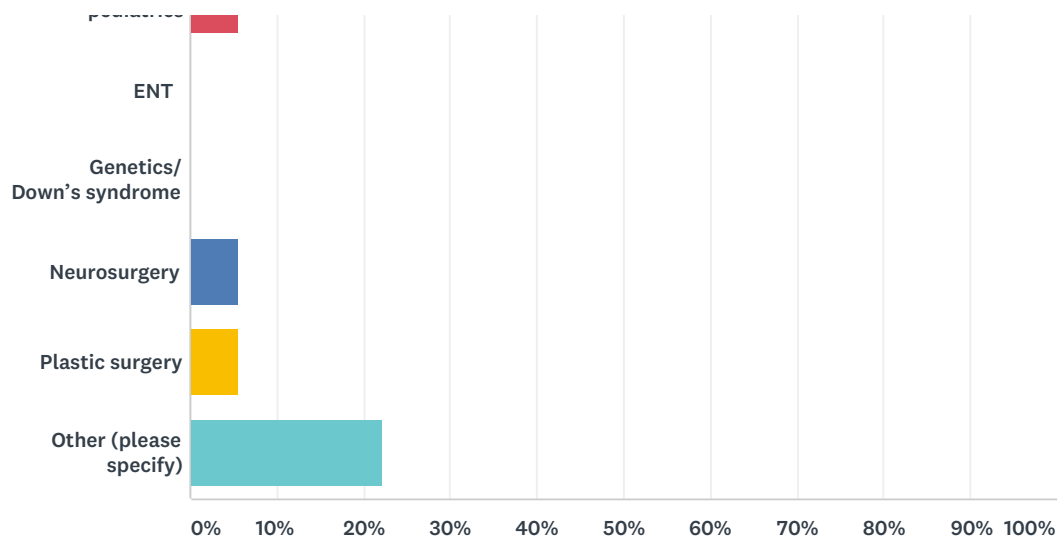

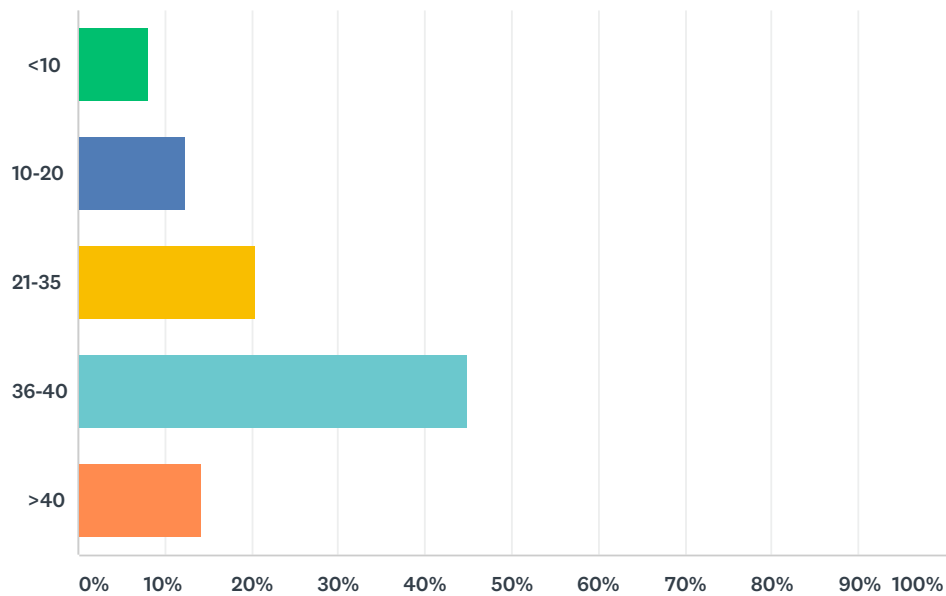

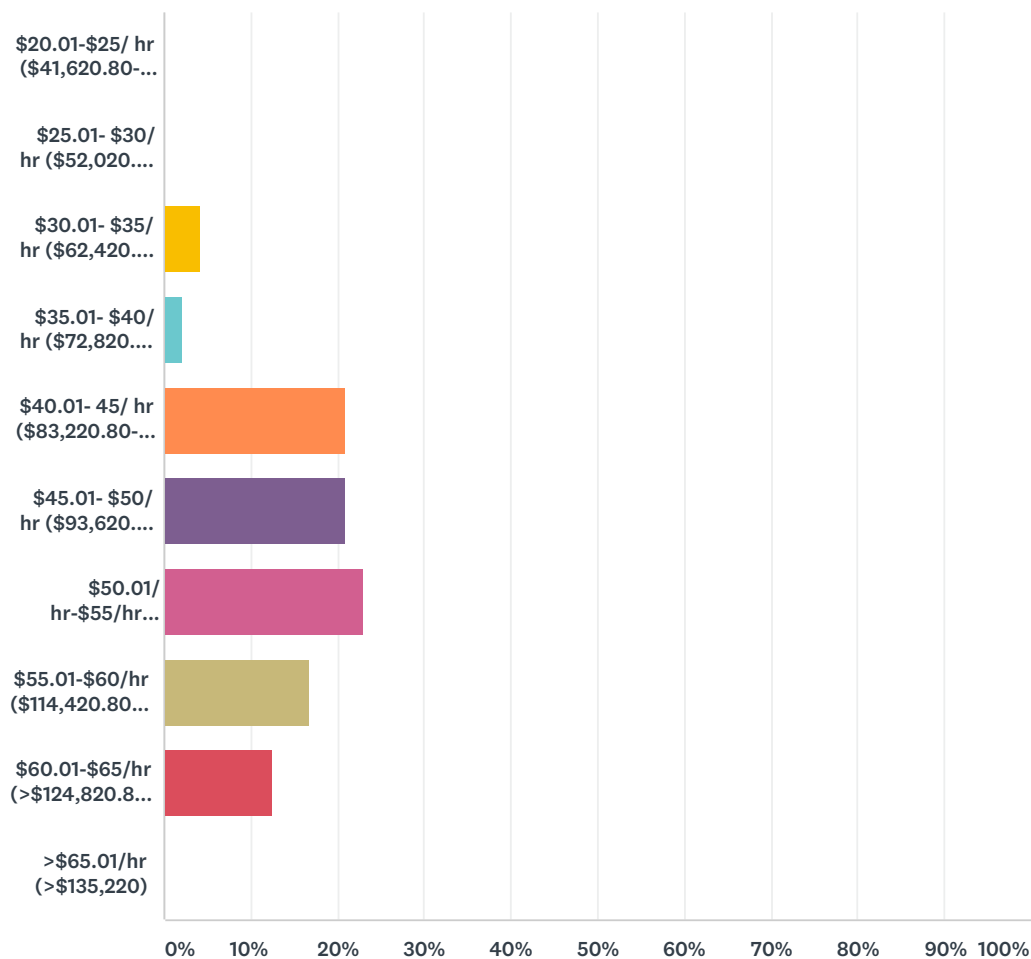

Q18 NP wage /hr (equivalent full-time yearly salary)

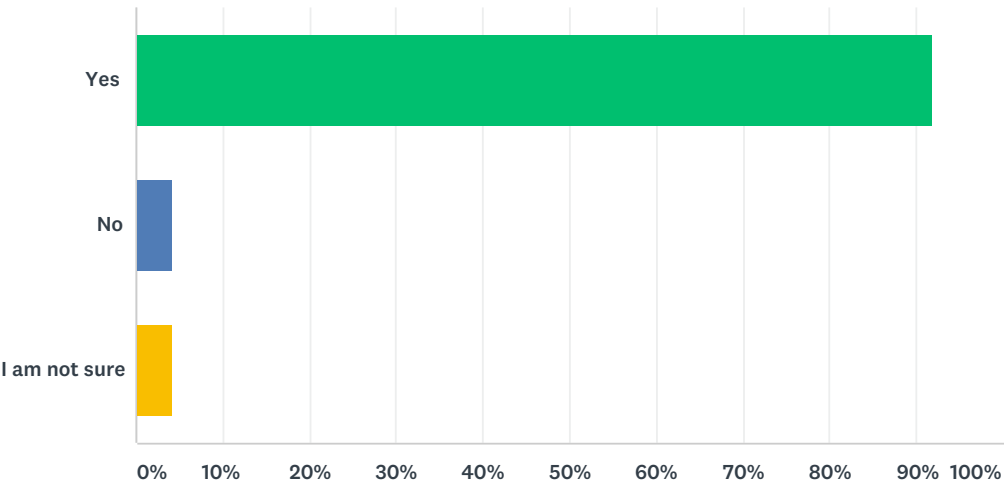

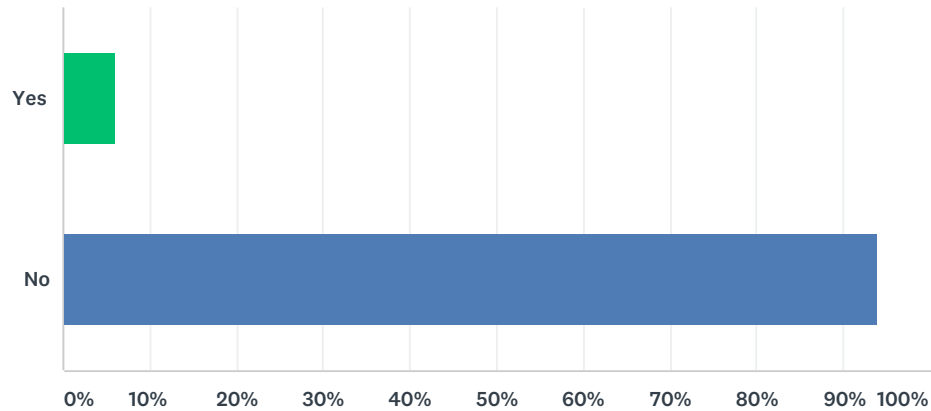

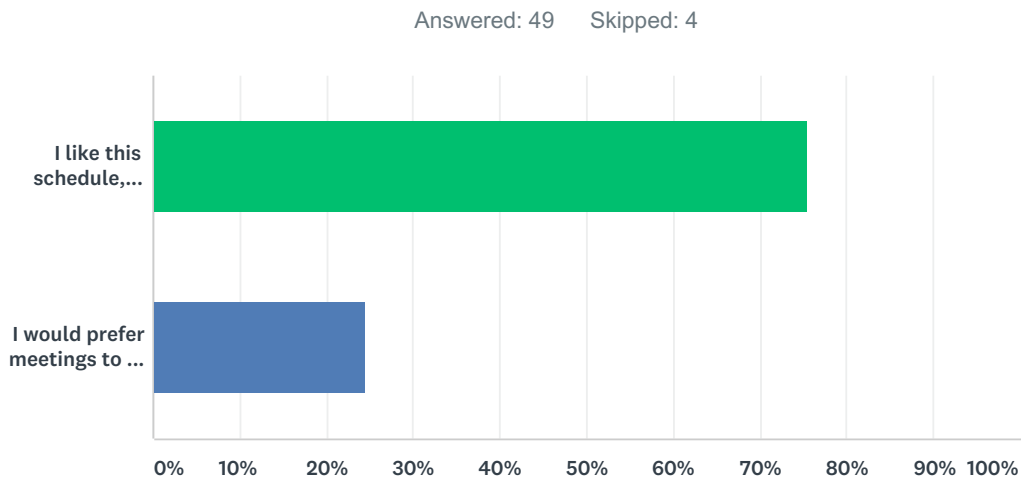

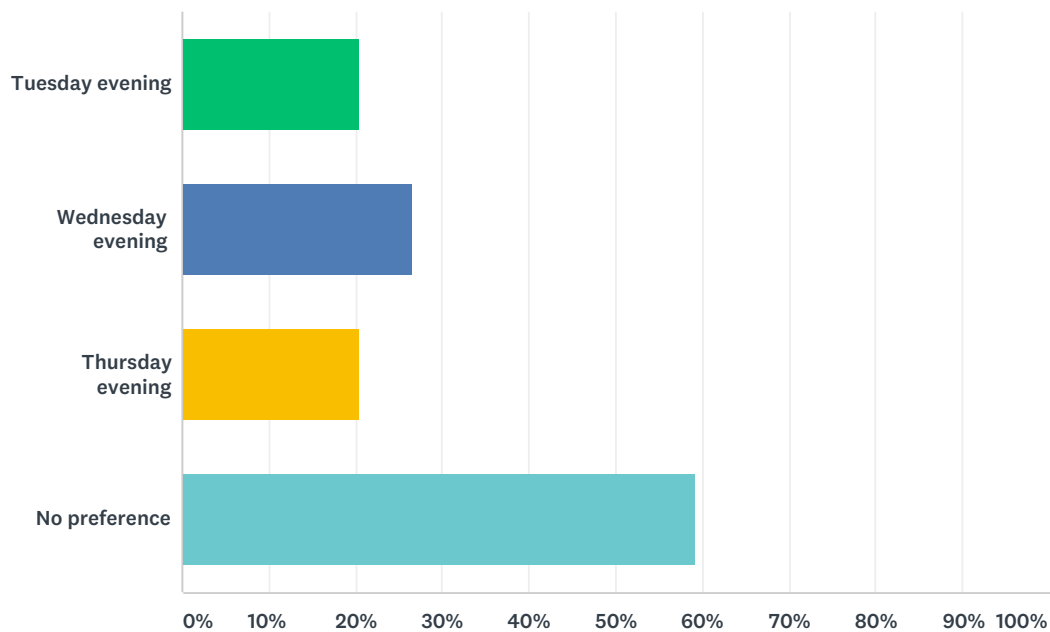

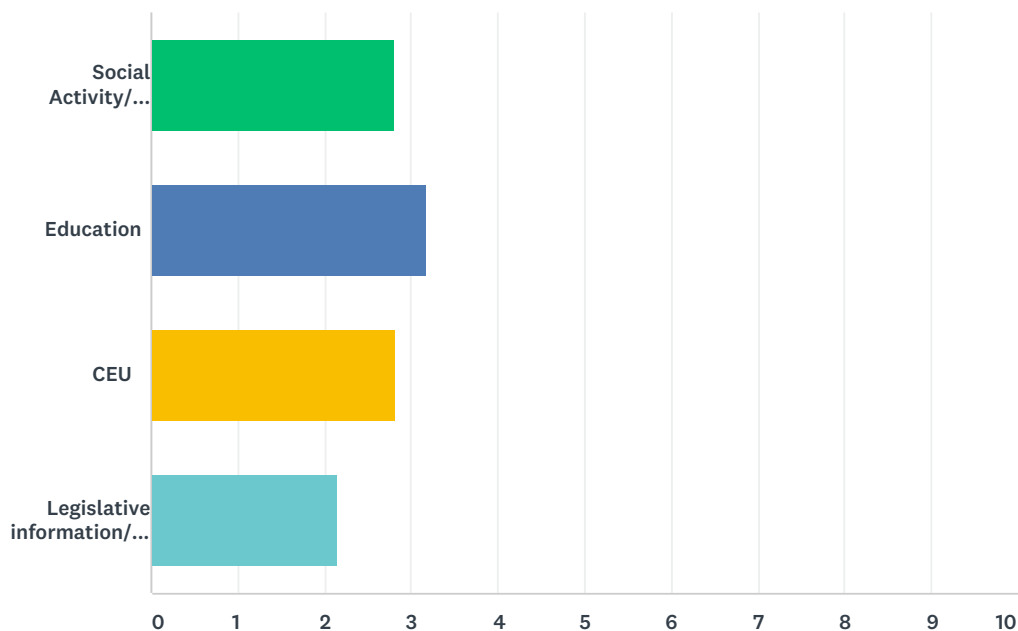

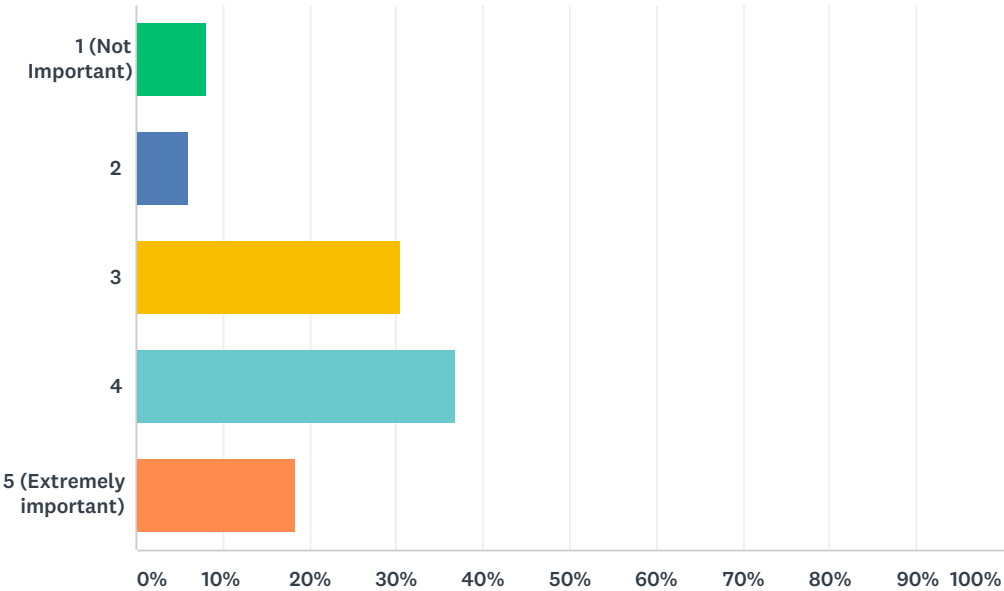

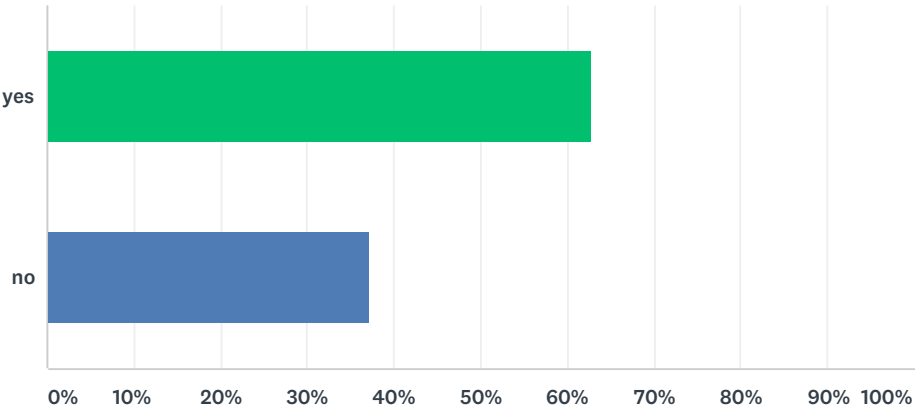

Q26 Would you be interested in a 4 Hr CEU event on a Saturday?

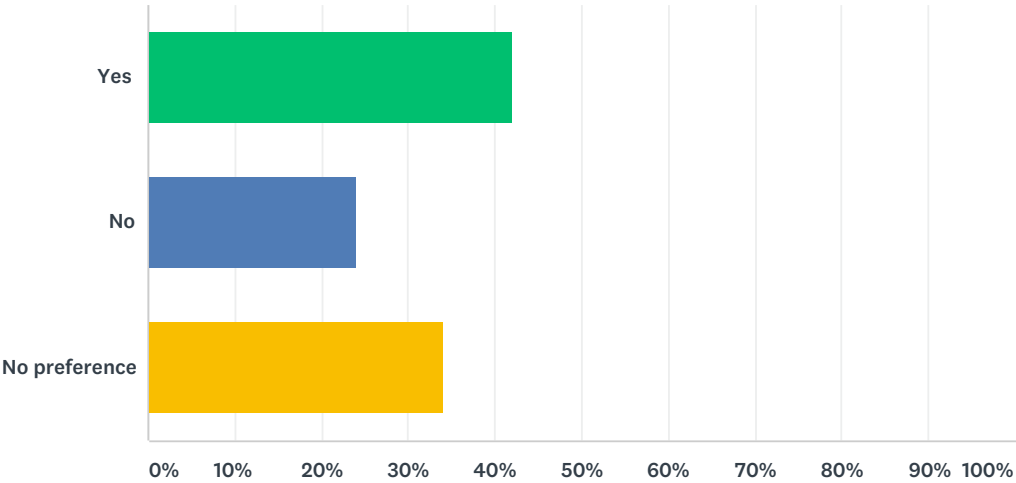

Q27 Would you be as likely to attend meetings sponsored by Pharmaceutical Reps, with a speaker, but no CEU?

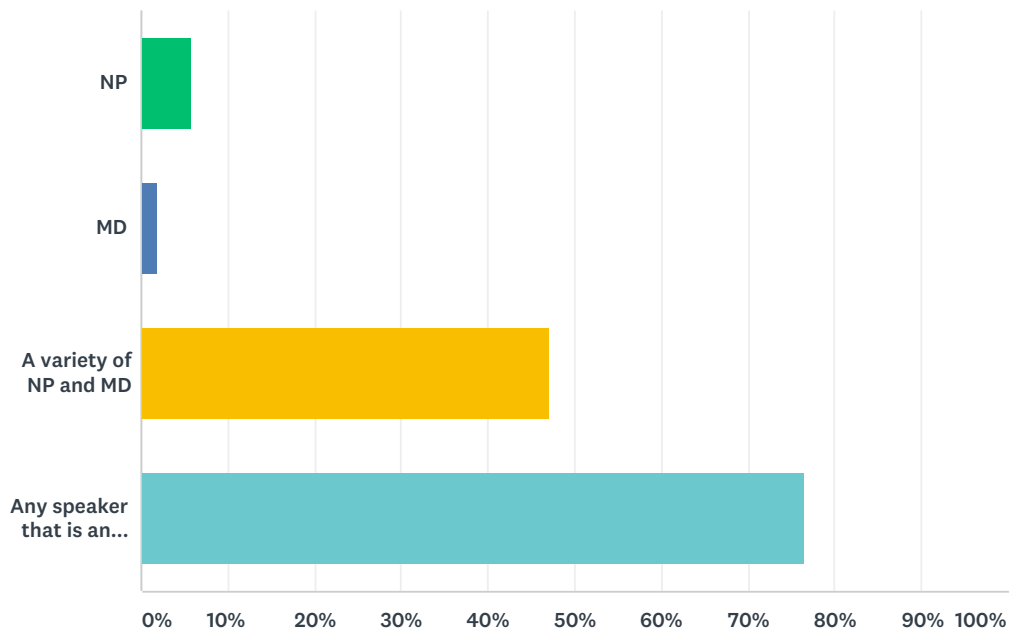
