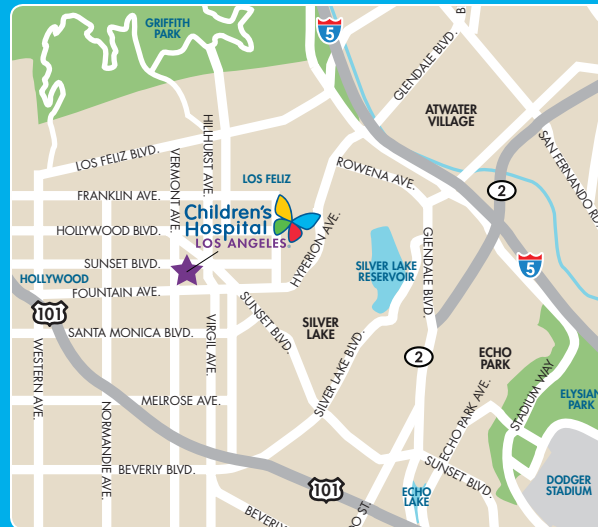


Objectives

- Incorporate the Caries Risk Assessment and Self-Management tools for oral care into practice
- Convey the value of applying fluoride varnish in children at risk for poor oral care
- Name the necessary tools needed to perform a good cardiac examination
- Recognize the causes of chest pain in the pediatric population and identify the possible cardiac signs
- Consider potential causes of sudden cardiac death in the pediatric population
