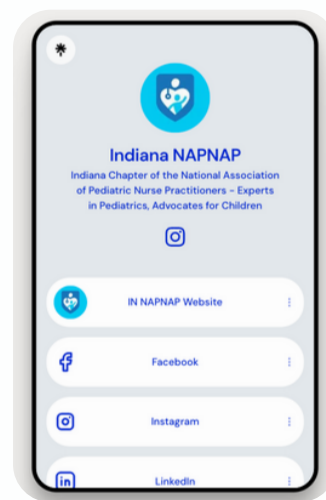
A NOTE FROM OUR NEW INDIANA NAPNAP PRESIDENT!

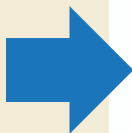
