SAVE Act updates:

- With Medicaid expansion, advocates for the SAVE act are focused on access to care especially in rural areas
- Remember that we are asking for full practice authority, not independent practice (no healthcare providers work independently!)
- The SAVE act has support from Gov. Cooper as well as Sen. Berger
- There are 24 community supporters/advocates (for example AARP, BCBS of NC) and zero groups that are not physician organizations that oppose it
- Between the House and the Senate there are 80 bill sponsors and it has bipartisian support which means that if the House allows it to out of the Health Committee, it has enough support to pass

- volunteer with NCNA Tuesdays at the Legislature (seems like it would be intimidating but it's not! There is always an experienced NP there to help)
- Join NCNA
- Donate to the NP PAC through NCNA
