FROM THE LEGISLATIVE CORNER

The expectation is that the budget will be passed within the next month, which in turn will finally put Medicaid expansion into action. Unfortunately, the SAVE act is not likely to pass during this session. However, the bill is still active so we will continue to advocate for its passage. The best way to do this is to contact your legislator, which you can find at

https://www.ncleg.gov/FindYourLegislators and also to sign up for Tuesdays at the Legislature.

Remember, the SAVE act is not about "independent" practice but rather full practice authority and increasing access to care, especially in light of the passage of Medicaid expansion. The SAVE act includes all 4 APRN roles: NP, CNS, CRNA and CNM. CNMs did have some practice restrictions lifted with the passage of SB 20 which has been referred to as the "abortion bill".
