Layers of Dignity helps sexual assault survivors take their first steps towards healing.

Sexual assault survivors who seek care are not allowed to bathe, shower, or brush their teeth before undergoing a forensic examination. Their clothes are often collected as evidence and survivors are usually sent home in paper hospital gowns.

Layers of Dignity provides tote bags filled with clothes, toiletries, and a handwritten letter from a fellow survivor.
