



CONFORMITY ASSESSMENT FEE STRUCTURE FOR On-Water Skill Course Third-Party Verification

A completed application form and indicated fee must be submitted to NASBLA with all of the necessary course materials. NASBLA will not commence processing an application until the appropriate application, supporting documentation, and the minimum fee is received.

The NASBLA website, www.nasbla.org/verifiedcourse, provides details on how to fill out and send the application materials for a conformity assessment of your course.

Each submitted course is assessed by NASBLA with review, as appropriate, of authoritative literature and the appropriate American National Standard for On-Water Skills.

- ☐ Course review must be completed within time frame stated in the application and procedures document unless written approval to extend this time frame is received by the course provider from NASBLA.

- ☐ It is the responsibility of the course provider to contact NASBLA with updates to course materials, contact information, web links, etc.
- ☐ Verified Mark remains in effect until standard is revised. Additional review may be required based on changes to standard for Verified Mark to remain in effect.
