



A completed application form and indicated fee must be submitted to NASBLA with all the necessary course materials. This fee does not apply to courses submitted by a state agency. **NASBLA will not commence processing an application until the appropriate application, supporting documentation, and fee is received.**

The NASBLA website, www.nasbla.org, provides you with details on how to fill out and send the application materials for a conformity assessment (a.k.a. NASBLA-Approval) of your course.

Each submitted course is assessed by NASBLA with review, as appropriate, of authoritative literature such as Federal Navigation Rules, Code of Federal Regulations. Coast Guard statistics and reports, NASBLA Administrative policy, and the minimum standards as amended and approved by the National Boating Standards Panel.
