



## *Paddlesports Committee*

2021-2022 Charges

**APPROVED**

- **PADDLE\_2022-1: Data & Trends**

- Develop additional paddlesports dashboards to include analytics regarding national and state-specific content and alternative funding data (use, views, and linkage). Review fatalities related to paddlecraft from incident data. Determine the number of paddlecraft fatalities nationwide and determine how many operators were self-directed or rental. The committee will also continue to provide recommendations and input on alternative funding and policy. (NASBLA 2.1, 2.5)

- **PADDLE\_2022-2: Outreach to Paddlecraft Liveries & Retailers Best Practices**

- Distribute best practices for paddlecraft rental liveries, such as outreach, gear, staff training and boater education. Provide models for states to collaborate with paddlecraft dealers to advance educational opportunities. Develop relationships with conservation/outdoor groups to provide and cross promote boating safety messages, content, and resources. Develop methods to effectively provide these resources and messaging to a diverse (ex., entry level, non-motorized, demographically) boating community for a better boating experience. (NASBLA 1.1, 1.4, 1.5, 2.1, 2.2, 2.3, 2.5,2.6) (RBS Initiative 1: CoA 1, CoA 2, CoA 3, Initiative 3)

- **PADDLE\_2022-3: Paddlecraft Access Inventory**

- Continue updating the Paddling Resources – State developed by the committee. (NASBLA 2.3)

- **20 PADDLE\_2022-4: Microlearning**

- Develop microlearning training to help facilitate opportunities for officers, educators and administrators. Suggested topics: paddling terminology and differences between paddlecraft and powerboats. Also explore produce microlearning directed toward paddlers. (NASBLA 2.6) (RBS Initiative 1)
