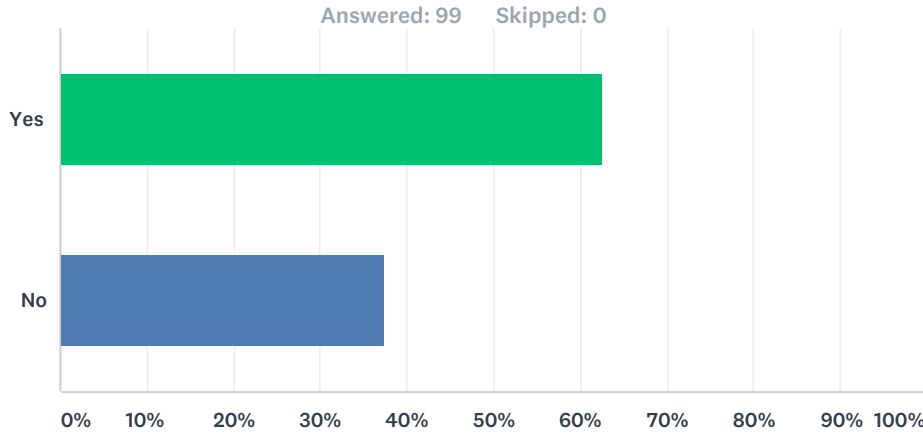
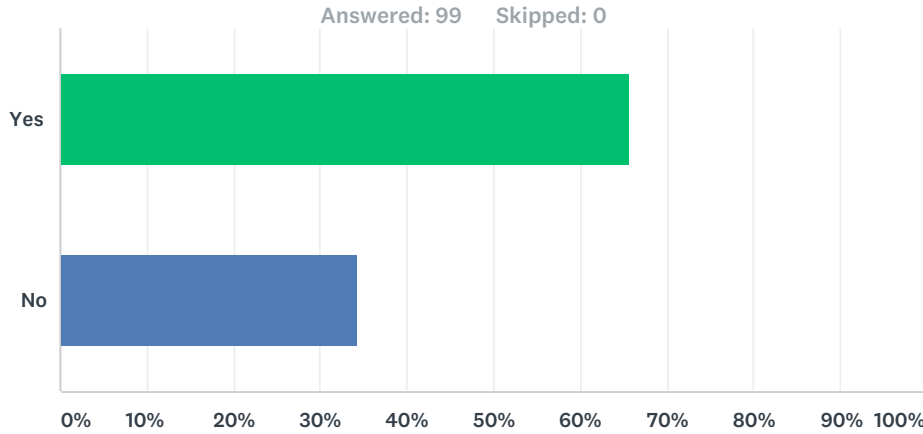


# Q1 If a subject refuses a chemical test following their arrest for BUI, does your agency seek a court-ordered blood draw by search warrant?



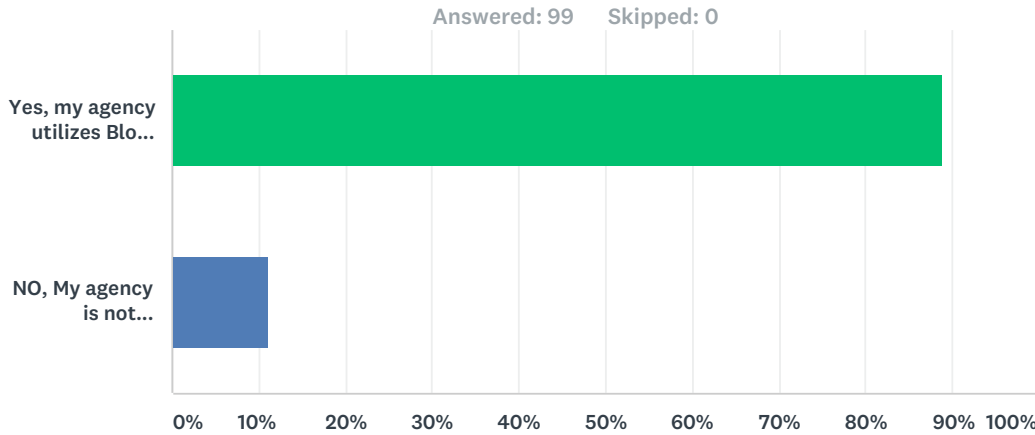

**Q2 Does your state have penalties in place for operators who refuse to submit a blood sample for chemical analysis? (i.e. loss of driver's license/operators license)**



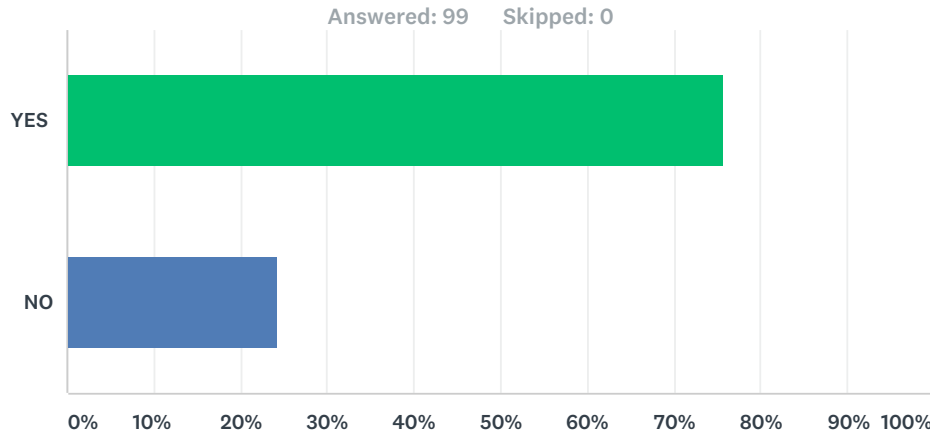

### Q3 If your agency successfully uses blood draws, how does your agency obtain samples?



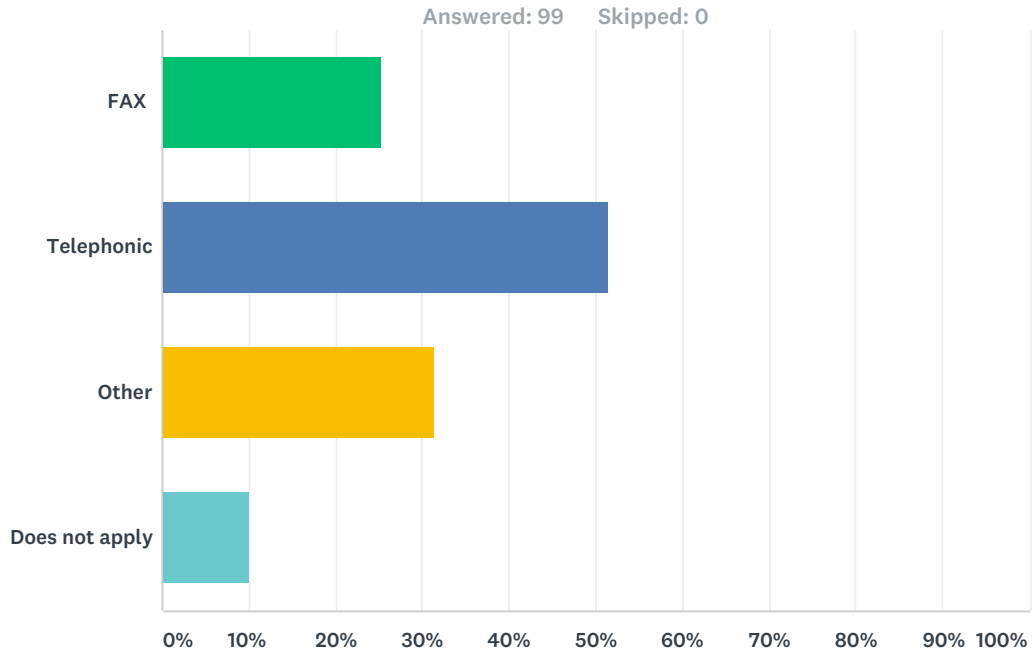

# Q4 Do the courts in your state support electronic media search warrants?



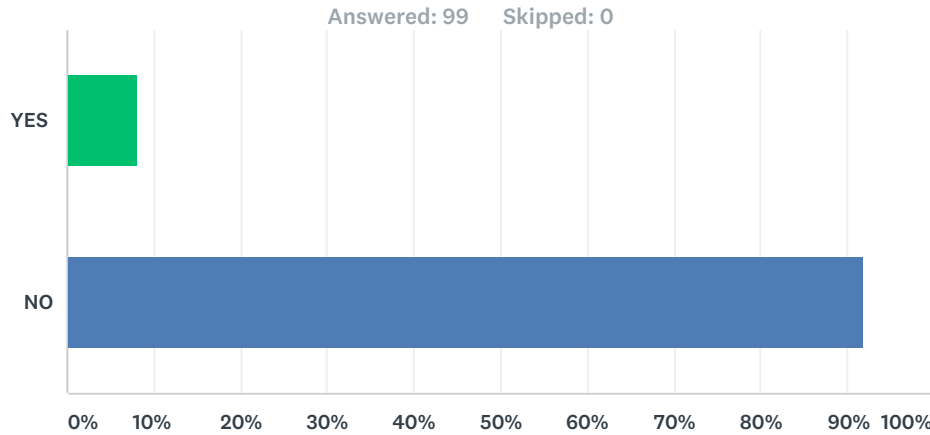
