
The Conference is Coming!

FASN Director Message

As the first semester of the 2016 – 2017 school year comes to a close, I want to THANK all Florida school nurses and extend FASN best wish-

es for a safe and blessed holiday break – you truly deserve it! The hard work that school nurses as health leaders do every day to support the health and wellbeing of Florida's children has a direct and significant impact on

students' academic success and future. FASN appreciates YOU!

My first year as your director representing Florida on the board of the National Association of School Nurses (NASN) has truly been a positive growth experience for me! My passion and support for the work of Florida school nurses has helped to sustain and strengthen me for the challenges of this position. During the June 2016 board meeting, the NASN board of directors approved a new definition of school nursing as a specialized practice of public health nursing, protects and promotes student health, facilitates normal development.

and advances academic success. School nurses, grounded in ethical and evidence-based practice, are the leaders that bridge

health care and education, provide care coordination, advocate for quality student-centered care, and collaborate to design systems that allow individuals and communities to develop their full potentials. The board of directors across the nation will meet again in February in our nation's capitol to review and approve revised documents (including NASN's strategic plan), celebrate successes, and identify opportunities for growth.

During the NASN board of directors annual 'trip to the hill', I will again have an opportunity to discuss the legislative priorities of NASN and Florida school nurses with our

state legislators. This year, I plan to focus on the American Academy of Pediatrics' recent (June 2016) policy statement recommending a minimum of one professional school nurse in every school, and to share and review Florida specific health data which demonstrate that our state data summary reports from 2008 to 2015 indicate: A 50% increase in students with chronic health conditions A 52% increase in students needing IHPs

A 212% increase in students needing medications or procedures

An overall decrease in <u>FDOH</u> and district funding (-\$34,190,943!)

All school nurses across the state should review their own county specific data and begin to have courageous conversations with school boards and district leaders. Students with chronic health conditions deserve access to a registered professional school nurse all day, every day! It is estimated that one in four students in the U.S. may have a chronic health condition and Florida's state data support this estimate with 27% of our students reported as having a health condition such as asthma, diabetes, or life threatening

KeepCalmAndPosters.com Florida school districts must recognize that school nurses, as health leaders, are im-

portant members of their interdisciplinary support teams who can and do make a significant and sustainable contribution to students' academic success, and life long health. Given opportunity, time and access, FASN believes that Florida school nurses (YOU!) are uniquely positioned to help their communities identify and develop creative ideas, supports and partnerships committed to improving student health and access to care.

We look forward to seeing all of you at the FASN 2017 conference in January as we continue Linking Health and Learning!
