



Treatment Components

- Psychiatric assessment and medication management
- Individual, group, and family therapy
- Cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT)
 - Behavioral activation (BA)
 - Exposure and response prevention (ERP)
 - Prolonged exposure (PE)
- Dialectical behavior therapy (DBT)
- Motivational interviewing
- 12-step facilitation
- Experiential therapy
- Patient and family education

Measuring Treatment Outcomes

- 314,238 annual patient days
- 22,325 admissions a year
- 1302 average number of patient treated per day
- 1 million patient self assessments a year
- 20 years of data from 30,000 patients

Treatment that works

91 % of patients across the Rogers system are improved at the time of discharge, according to the CGI score, the clinician-rated assessment of patient severity upon admissions and assement of improvement at time of discharge

Strategic priorities: clinical effectiveness, patient experience, healthy culture, community outreach, financial effectiveness

Rogers Behavioral Health - Miami

- Rogers in Miami opened in November 2019.
- Multi-disciplinary team including 2 Psychiatrists,
 Masters level clinicians, PhD Clinical leadership
- Treatment offered in Spanish or English- fully Spanish speaking treatment providers
- In network with most private insurances

Child, Adolescent and Adult Services- Telehealth with few exceptions

- Partial hospitalization care (PHP) 30 hours a week
- Intensive outpatient care (IOP) 15 hours a week
- Program options:
 - OCD and Anxiety
 - Children ages 6 to 11, Adults
 - Teens ages 12 to 17, Adults
 - Depression Recovery
 - Teens ages 12 to 17, Adults

- Admission begins with a free screening
 - Phone screening takes about 45 minutes, longer with more complexity
 - Medical staff reviews the screening to make a program recommendation
 - Admission staff contacts patient/family and proceeds with process
