Along with the reduced fee, we offer scholarships to our campers based on their income and needs. CAMP FACILITIES

We utilize two different locations for our Camp Endres camping programs, Camp Twin Cedars in Guthrie, OK and YMCA Camp Classen in Davis, OK. Our overnight programs at each location have cabins with central heat and air. Our infirmary is accessible 24/7 with medical professionals on call so campers have all of the medical care needed for any reason.

OUR STAFF

We are thankful for our dedicated staff members at Camp Endres. Our staff consists of volunteer counselors, medical staff and health students that are put into teams to ensure that all campers stay safe and healthy at Camp Endres. Medical staff supervises camper's diabetes management as well as any other medical needs. Counselors supervise campers during activities and provide campers with positive role models.
