RN to BSN Education Advancement Scholarship	Up to \$1,500 to assist with the expenses for a school nurse to pursue a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Current NASN membership status for the past two years</li> <li>Current license as registered nurse in state of employment</li> <li>Current employment for at least .6 FTE as a nurse in a school for the past two years</li> <li>Current acceptance or enrollment in an educational program</li> </ul>	<p>Annually on <b>October 15</b></p> <p><i>Applications are submitted electronically</i></p>
