Endowment Education Scholarship	Amount is based on available Endowment Funds. Annual Conference registration	- Current and active NASN membership status for the past two years - Current license as registered nurse in state of employment - Current full-time employment as a school nurse - Current acceptance or enrollment in an educational program - Have a baccalaureate degree or higher (this degree does not need to be in nursing) - committee may make exceptions for applicants pursuing a combined BSN/MSN degree	Annually on October 15 <i>Applications are submitted electronically</i>
Advocacy Education Scholarship	Up to \$1,500. Annual Conference Registration	- Current NASN membership status for the past two years - Current licensure as a registered nurse and current employment as a school nurse for at least 0.6 FTE for the previous two years - Hold a bachelor's degree or higher (this degree does not have to be in nursing)	Annually on October 15 <i>Applications are submitted electronically</i>
RN to BSN Education Advancement Scholarship	Up to \$1,500 to assist with the expenses for a school nurse to pursue a Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree	- Current NASN membership status for the past two years - Current license as registered nurse in state of employment - Current employment for at least .6 FTE as a nurse in a school for the past two years - Current acceptance or enrollment in an educational program	Annually on October 15 <i>Applications are submitted electronically</i>
New Member Scholarship	One award of up to \$1,500 for In-Person NASN Annual Conference Expenses. One Complimentary Virtual Conference Registration.	- Current license as registered nurse in state of employment - Current employment as a school nurse - Join NASN for the first time during the 12-month period ending March 31 of current year	No application is required
