Lake Charles, Calcasieu Parish



Lake Charles is the fifth-largest incorporated city in the US. Located on Lake Charles, Prien Lake, and the Calcasieu River. Founded in 1861 in Calcasieu Parish, it is a major industrial, cultural, and educational center in the southwest region of the state. It is considered a major center of petrochemical refining, gaming, tourism, and education, being home to McNeese State University and Sowela Technical Community College. Because of the lakes and waterways throughout the city, metropolitan Lake Charles is often referred to as the Lake Area. The top employer, the Calcasieu Parish School System, employs approximately 5,000 workers. Several petrochemical plants and an oil refinery are located nearby along the Calcasieu Ship Channel and employ over a thousand engineers. Lake Charles has an array of shopping from small family business to many big box stores serving as the shopping and retail hub of the five-parish area.

Lake Charles boast five diverse museums, one of which houses the largest display of Mardi Gras costumes in the world, in addition to charming galleries rich with art. Taste world-famous Cajun and Creole cuisine or a drive along the Creole Nature Trail All-American Road—teeming with wildlife, including alligators, birds and three wildlife refuges! Visitors can also stroll through the Charpentier Historic District with lead crystal glass glittering in the lamp-light.
