HB 770	Allen, Alma(D)	Relating to the salary and wages paid to public school employees. <div><b>Companions:</b> <a href="#">HB 3296</a>   Allen, Alma   (Refiled from 87R Session)</div> <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would give school employees raises, with nurses getting a \$400/month raise.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 02-28-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Appropriations</div>
HB 777	Vasut, Cody(R)	Relating to prohibiting face covering mandates for public school students, prohibiting public schools from requiring students to provide documentation regarding certain vaccinations. <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would prohibit schools from requiring students to wear a face mask to prevent the spread of an infectious disease. It would also prohibit schools from requiring documentation of vaccination status for COVID-19.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 02-28-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 807	Harrison, Brian(R)	Relating to immunization requirements. <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would remove DSHS's authority to require immunizations beyond what is mandated by state law. State law requires only diphtheria, rubella, rubella, mumps, tetanus, and poliomyelitis vaccinations. The bill would also prohibit government entities from requiring vaccines not required by state law.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-01-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Health</div>
HB 920	Klick, Stephanie(R)	Relating to the use of medication designated for treatment of respiratory distress on public and private school campuses. <div><b>Companions:</b> <a href="#">SB 294</a>   Johnson, Nathan   (Identical) 2-15-23 S Introduced and referred to committee on Senate Education</div> <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would remove the requirement that a student have a written notification that the student has been diagnosed with asthma in order for them to receive treatment from a school nurse for respiratory distress. It would also allow other school personnel to administer the medication and require training for those persons to do so.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-02-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 1060	Guerra, Bobby(D)	Relating to the implementation of telehealth services programs at certain public primary and secondary schools and the appointment of a telehealth services program task force. <div><b>Companions:</b> <a href="#">SB 662</a>   Lamantia, Morgan (F)   (Identical) 2-17-23 S Introduced and referred to committee on Senate Education</div> <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would require all schools that do not employ a full-time nurse to implement a telehealth services program. It would also create a telehealth services task force to make recommendations on these programs.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-02-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 1061	Guerra, Bobby(D)	Relating to a notification requirement concerning the availability of nurses on the campus of a public school, including an open-enrollment charter school. <div><b>Companions:</b> <a href="#">HB 1370</a>   Guerra, Bobby   (Refiled from 87R Session)</div> <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would require schools to provide written notice regarding the availability of a school nurse on campus. The notice would be required not later than 30 days after the first day of school and any change to the nurse's schedule. The notice could be satisfied by a website posting, but it must be accessible from the home page by use of not more than three links.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-02-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 1139	Thierry, Shawn(D)	Relating to the employment of full-time registered nurses at public schools. <div><b>Companions:</b> <a href="#">HB 181</a>   Thierry, Shawn   (Refiled from 87R Session)</div> <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would require schools to employ at least one full-time nurse at each campus and maintain an average ratio of one nurse for every 750 students.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-02-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 1149	Swanson, Valoree(R)	Relating to requiring parental consent for psychological or psychiatric examination, testing, or treatment conducted by a school district employee. <div><b>Companions:</b> <a href="#">SB 400</a>   Hall, Bob   (Identical) 2-15-23 S Introduced and referred to committee on Senate Education</div> <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would broaden the definition of psychological and psychiatric treatment and examination, which requires parental consent in school. Treatment would include use of a method, technique, or substance that is designed to affect behavioral, emotional, or attitudinal characteristics.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-02-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 1155	Patterson, Jared(R)	Relating to parental rights in public education and prohibiting instruction regarding sexual orientation or gender identity for certain public school students. <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would require school districts to provide a copy of any well-being questionnaire or health screening form to parents and obtain the parents consent to administer it. It would also require schools to provide parents with a notice of all health-related services offered at the campus, which must include a statement of the parent's right to decline health-related services.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-02-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 1238	VanDeaver, Gary(R)	Relating to the school health and related services program, including parental consent for program services, the establishment of a school health and related services program advisory council. <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would create a SHARS advisory committee, which would be tasked with advising HHSC on implementing the SHRS program, incorporating changes to federal law governing the program, and publishing the procedures manual.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-03-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Human Services</div>
HB 1281	Jones, Jolanda (F)(D)	Relating to a notification requirement if a public school, including an open-enrollment charter school, does not have a nurse assigned to the school during all instructional hours. <div><b>Companions:</b> <a href="#">HB 1854</a>   Thierry, Shawn   (Identical) 2- 3-23 H Filed <a href="#">HB 2176</a>   Cole, Sheryl   (Identical) 2-10-23 H Filed <a href="#">SB 193</a>   Miles, Borris   (Identical) 2-15-23 S Introduced and referred to committee on Senate Education</div> <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would require schools to notify parents if they do not have a full-time nurse present for more than 30 consecutive days.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-03-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 1297	Dutton, Harold(D)	Relating to vision screenings for students in public or private school. <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would allow students to be screened using an electronic eye chart.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-03-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 1298	Dutton, Harold(D)	Relating to menstrual disorders education and informational materials for public school students. <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would allow school districts to provide informational materials to students regarding menstrual disorders and symptoms, such as endometriosis.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-03-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 1334	Gervin-Hawkins, Barbara(D)	Relating to requiring cultural inclusion curriculum as part of the enrichment curriculum for public schools. <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would require the State Board of Education to develop a curriculum on cultural inclusivity and would require school districts and open-enrollment charter schools to have a cultural inclusion course in their curriculum.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-03-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 1548	Talarico, James(D)	Relating to the salary and wages paid to public school employees. <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would give school employees a raise, with nurses getting a \$1,500/month raise.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-03-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Public Education</div>
HB 1571	Lozano, Jose(R)	Relating to the reimbursement under Medicaid of local educational agencies for the provision of health care services to students. <div><b>Companions:</b> <a href="#">HB 2773</a>   Bucy, John   (Identical) 2-23-23 H Filed</div> <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would allow LEAs to bill Medicaid for any services covered by Medicaid that are provided to any student eligible for Medicaid.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-03-23 H Introduced and referred to committee on House Human Services</div>
HB 2891	Talarico, James(D)	Relating to the use of prescription glucagon medication on public and private school campuses. <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would allow glucagon to be prescribed in the name of a school. The school could maintain the glucagon, and it could be administered by a school nurse or an unlicensed diabetes care assistant.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 02-27-23 H Filed</div>
SB 1506	Hughes, Bryan(R)	Relating to a seizure management and treatment plan for the care to be provided by a public school to a student with a seizure disorder. <div><b>Remarks:</b> This bill would add detailed requirements to the standardized form used for seizure management and treatment plans. The bill would add that the form must include medical history, contact information of guardians, frequency of seizures, triggers, responses, and response protocols, among other things.</div> <div><b>Bill History:</b> 03-03-23 S Filed</div>
