OSHNA Nursing Scholarship

1. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded to a high school student, pursuing a degree in nursing, and currently attending an international or DoDEA high school. The scholarship may assist with books and study materials.
2. The scholarship money will be awarded via check from OSHNA.
3. Notification of the award will occur in May and shared on the OSHNA website and Facebook page.

Application Requirements: completed application, completed ID Form, signed official high school transcript, 2 letters of reference, 2 essays (500 words each)

Application Deadline: April 15

Selection Process:

The complete application packet will be carefully evaluated by the scholarship committee. Selection criteria are equally based on academic excellence, service and leadership, essays, and letters of reference.

Notification Process:

The OSHNA Nursing Scholarship winner will be notified via email in May. A check will be mailed directly to the recipient.
