Know someone that would fit? Suggest their name be put on the April ballot.

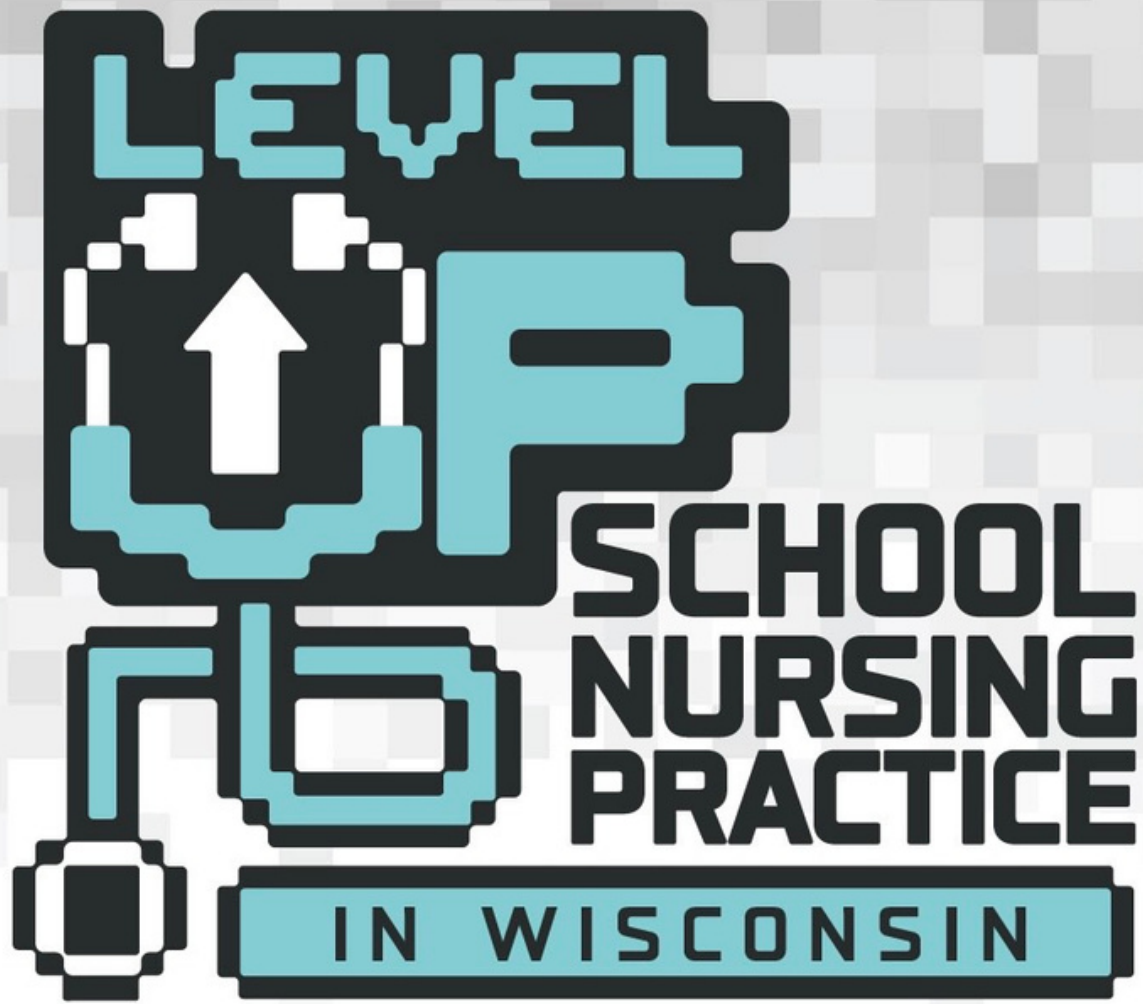
