Make a Wish: Joe Evenson. Senior Director Program Services for Make-A-Wish South Dakota & Montana. In this session, we'll cover all aspects of our wish journey that's been created to help guide each one of our kids that we serve through the transformative power of a wish. We'll discuss and answer the following questions: Who is Make-A-Wish? What does Make-A-Wish do? Who qualifies for a wish? How do we come up with the wishes we grant? What is the impact of a wish?
