About NASN

Founding of NASN

On July 4, 1968, the National Education Association established the Department of School Nurses. The DSN became a separate entity known as NASN. The first secretary-treasurer of NASN was Barbara French from New Hampshire. The first meeting of NASN was held in 1969 in Philadelphia, PA.



NASN Today


NASN has nearly **20,000** members and **50 affiliates**, including one overseas.

NASN is classified under the Internal Revenue Code as a 501(c)(3) Public Charity.


2016: NHSNA honored Barbara French with the first School Health Advocacy Award




From 1963 to 1990, Barbara was a school nurse at Rundlett Junior High in Concord. Upon her retirement, she took her knowledge of school nursing to her legislative practice as a NH State Representative for 24 years representing Merrimack District 6 until her full retirement at the age of 90. She was a constant advocate for school health and was most proud of the creation of the New Hampshire Healthy Kids Corporation and the Child and Family Resource Centers.



Advocating


The organization delivers timely information to NH State Legislators on health and policy matters affecting school nursing within New Hampshire.





SCHOLARSHIPS ~ SCHOLARSHIPS ~ SCHOLARSHIPS!

1. NHSNA: Up to four \$500 scholarships per year for accredited course work toward a nursing-related degree. OR for the NSCN exam fee. (a)
2. **NASN: RN to BSN Education Advancement Scholarship** One scholarship (up to \$1,500) will be awarded, to assist with expenses for a school nurse to pursue a Bachelor of Science in Nursing. (b)
3. **NASN: Endowment Education Scholarship** The NASN Scholarship Committee will up to \$2,500 to a member pursuing post baccalaureate certification or graduate degrees. (b)
4. **NASN: New Member Scholarship** Nurses who join NASN for the first time are eligible for this scholarship. All new members joining between April 1st and March 31st are entered into a drawing to win up to \$1500 to attend the national conference in June. No need to apply! New members are automatically entered!
5. **NASN: Advocacy Education Scholarship** Up to \$1500 to provide financial support for a school nurse to participate in an advocacy education program. Plus, free entrance to the June conference.
6. **NASN Research Grants** The total amount available for grants awarded in 2026 is \$25,000. Applications may range from \$1,000-\$25,000.

Discounted Online Tuition



[Chamberlain Act Grant](#) for the RN to BSN program that caps the tuition at \$5250 per reimbursement year.
