

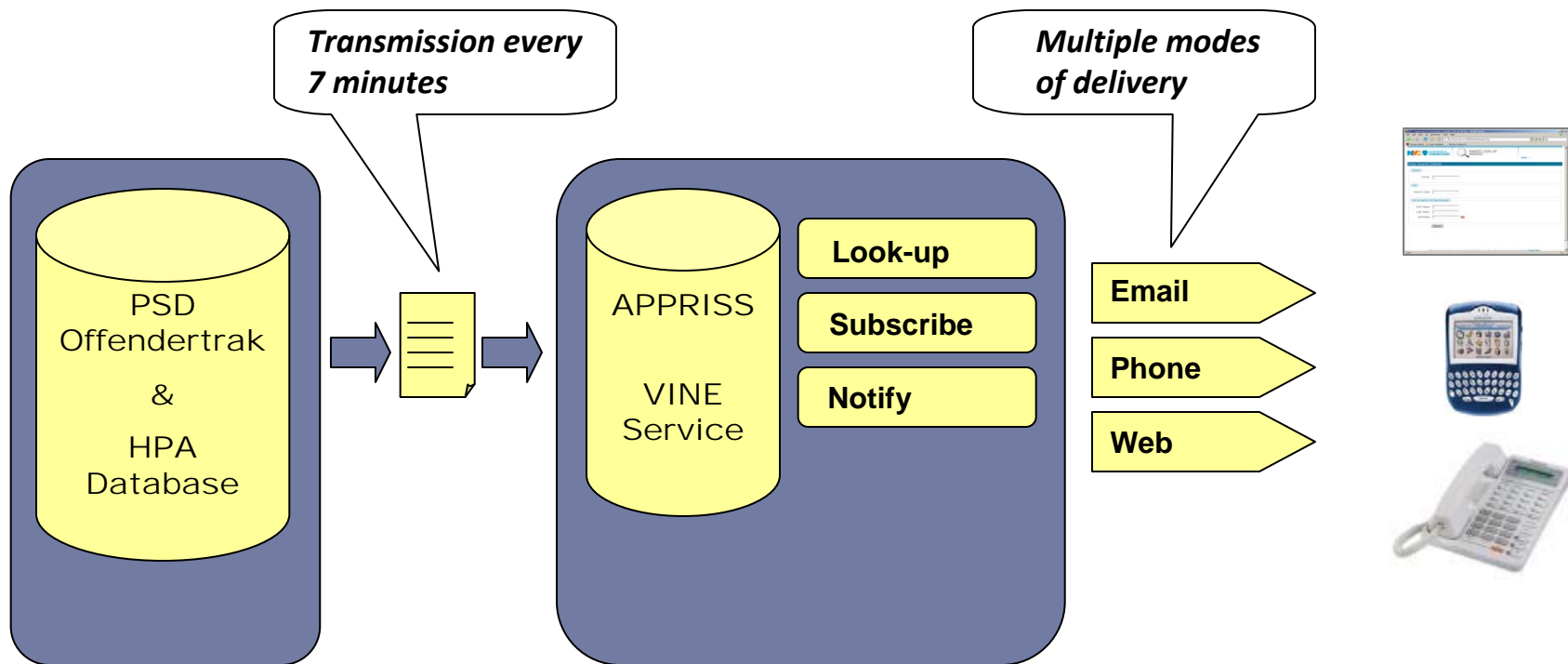

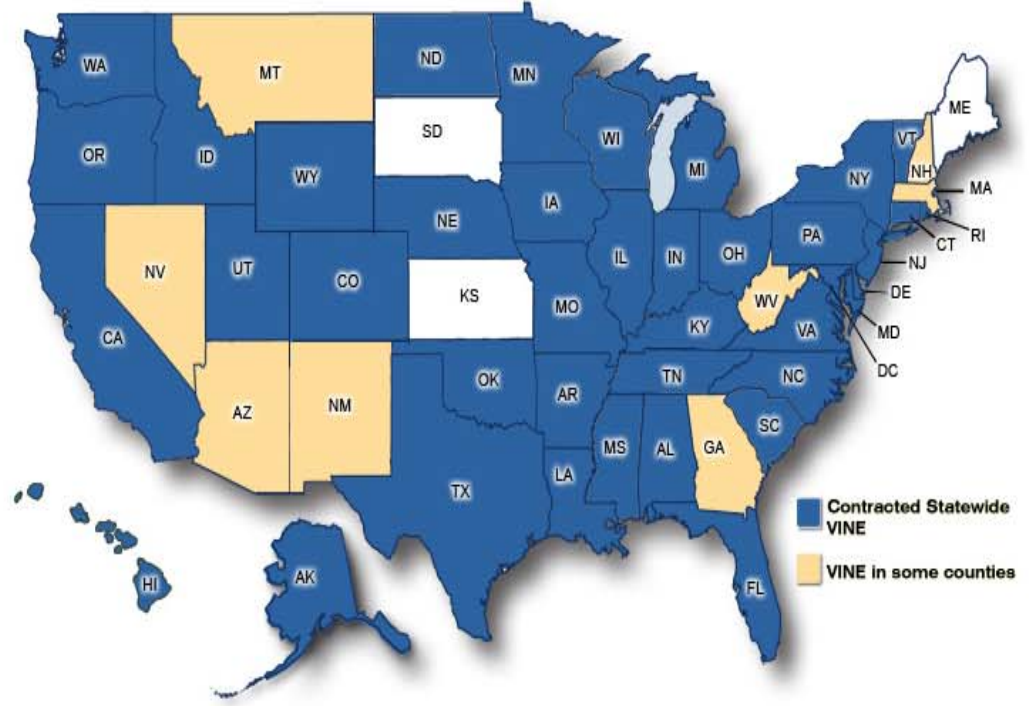
About VINELink

VINELink is the online version of VINE (Victim Information and Notification Everyday), the National Victim Notification Network. This service allows crime victims to obtain timely and reliable information about criminal cases and the custody status of offenders 24 hours a day. Victims and other concerned citizens can also register to be notified by phone, email or TTY device when an offender's custody status changes. Users can also register through their participating state or county toll-free number.

To use VINELink

- ✔ Click on the state where your offender is located.
- ✔ From the menu you may choose to search for the offender by name or identification number.
- ✔ Follow the instructions provided to complete the registration process.

Welcome to the Hawaii Statewide Automated Victim Information and Notification (SAVIN) system powered by VINE (Victim Information and Notification Everyday).

Hawaii SAVIN offers victims and concerned citizens free, anonymous, and confidential access to timely information and notification 24-hours a day, 365 days a year on the custody and parole status of offenders under the jurisdiction of the State Of Hawaii's Department of Public Safety.

To get started: click on the OFFENDERS tab or UPDATE REGISTRATION information in the boxes located in the left margin. Registered users will receive notification via email and telephone with live operator assistance always available to address your questions.

Hawaii SAVIN, a project of the Department of Public Safety, is provided by a grant from the US Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance and supported by victim witness assistance programs throughout the State.

Please do not depend solely on this program for your protection. Maintain contacts with your advocate, attorney, or law enforcement officers assigned to your case. An offender will never know if you are registered for notification.

Register for Notification

Do not depend only on the VINE service, or any other single program, for your protection. If you feel you may be at risk, take precautions as though the offender has already been released. If you have any questions about your protection, please call your local law enforcement agency.

Phone Notification

When the custody status of your offender changes, VINE will call the phone number you specify and you will hear a recorded alert message. We will continue to call at a pre-determined frequency until you enter your four-digit Personal Identification Number.

Email Notification

When the custody status of your offender changes, VINE will send a notification email message to the address you specify. You will receive only one message, which will include instructions on how to proceed. Please add the following email address to your email address book or white-list to prevent VINE email notifications from being blocked by a spam filter: vine@globalnotifications.com

Events that Trigger Notification

- ▶ **Escape**
 - ▶ issuance of HPA warrants
- ▶ **Release**
 - ▶ bail, court order, discharge, parole, federal or other state sentences, INS for deportation
- ▶ **Transfer**
 - ▶ between facilities, other jurisdictions
- ▶ **Return to custody**
 - ▶ parole retakes, re-arrests
- ▶ **Unsupervised custody**
 - ▶ Weekenders, passes
- ▶ **Deceased**
