What are the dates of the 2021 Classroom Assessment Conference?

October 21 and 22.

Will sessions be recorded?

Yes, all sessions will be recorded and made available on demand 48 hours after the end of the conference.

How long will I have access to the 2021 Classroom Assessment platform?

You will have access until December 22, 2022.

What time zone are the streamed sessions shown?

All sessions will be shown in your time zone.

What browser should I be using for the best experience?

Do I need to have Zoom installed to participate?

Yes, you will need to download Zoom onto your machine if you do not already have it installed. [Learn More](#).

Can I use my iPhone/Android/tablet to access the event and watch the sessions?

Although we recommend accessing the platform via desktop browser for the best experience, you can use mobile devices as well. Please ensure that your mobile device is connected to a stable internet connection. A connection of 3 Mbps or higher is recommended.

When do I get access to my session as a speaker?

- **15-20 minutes before the start time:** speakers and room managers can start or join the live meeting and be seen/heard only by other admins. All other attendees will be able to join the live meeting **1 minute before the start time**.

Why are my co-authors not listed on my session on the virtual program?

Only registered speakers/authors will show under your session. All authors are listed on the full Program.

I should be listed as a speaker in my session. How do I fix this?

If there is a session that you should be listed as a speaker, but you are not listed, please confirm your registration for the conference and reach out to Leslie Grant (lwgran@wm.edu) ASAP so we can get this fixed.

Why are there no papers/posters uploaded to a session?

It is the responsibility of the speaker to upload their paper/poster. If there are no files, then the speaker has not uploaded anything. Please feel free to direct message the speaker.

Is there a maximum number of people who can join a session?

Yes, there is a maximum of 500 people who can join a session.
