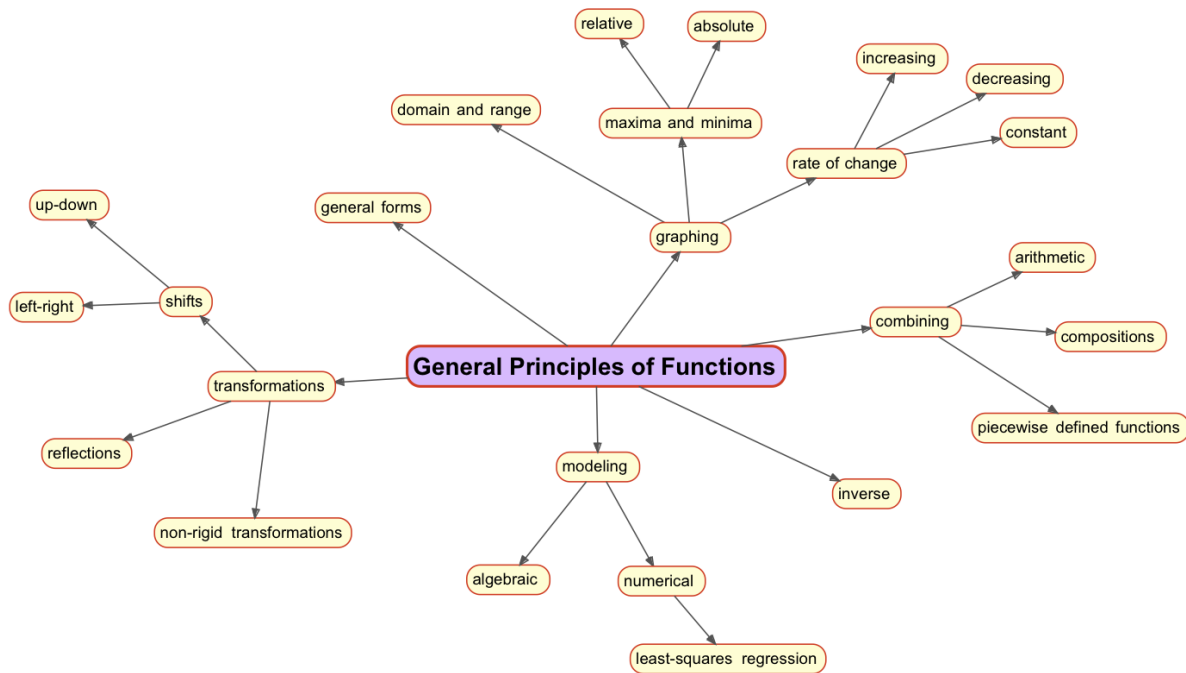


CONCEPT MAP

A concept map is a diagram that visually organizes concepts and the relationships between them. Here is a concept map of the general principles of mathematical functions from montessorimuddle.org:



Students' concept maps can tell you a lot about their understanding of important ideas, and how they relate to each other. There are many free online concept map-making apps (<https://www.educatorstechnology.com/2018/01/9-great-concept-mapping-tools-for.html>).

A review of your students' maps will indicate what they know and what they misunderstand, and allow you to plan your lessons accordingly.
