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

The Origins of B.A.S.E



The Children's Assessment Center, in collaboration with the Harris County District Attorney's Office, offers a pre-adjudicated diverstion program for youth who have engaged in problematic sexual bheaviors that could result in criminal charges.



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What is a pre-adjudicated diversion program?

Adjudicated Youths: A youth who has been found by a judge in juvenile court to have committed a violation of the criminal law, that is, a delinquent act. The judge can formally adjudicate the youth as an initial step before imposing a disposition (a sentence or punishment), or the judge can decide not to adjudicate the youth and instead impose conditions that, if met, will result in dismissal of the charges (placed on legal diversion)

Pre-adjudicated youth: Pre-adjudication diversion is defined as providing opportunities for youth who would otherwise face formal processing in the court system. The goal is to avoid an adjudication of delinquency or conviction for a summary offense.



Our Pre-adjudicated youth:

- Never see a court room
- No lawyer fees
- No probation officers
- Juvenile Record only showing investigation and alleged offense
 - Not listed as guilty
- No Sex Offender Registration
- No ongoing court trauma
- Minimizing the self- fulfilling prophecy




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B.A.S.E. Referrals

- Harris Country District Attorney Juvenile Sexual Assault Intake Panel
- Meets every Friday morning via Zoom
- Law enforcement to contact: Administrative Assistant to schedule a time to present
- Panel will make one of the following decisions regarding each case:
 - Decline Charges
 - File Charges
 - Request additional information from LE
 - Refer to the BASE Program for treatment







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B.A.S.E. Referral Procedures

- Law Enforcement with contact families and submit BASE referral and copy Offense Report
- 2) The BASE Administrative Assistant will update our excel BASE waiting list and incoming referrals folder
- 3. The PSB Program Coordinator will then contact the YPSB's guardians to confirm family's compliance and vet the referral.
- 4. BASE Referral Assigned to Clinician

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B.A.S.E. Treatment Goals

- Enhance Empathy for Victim
- Recognize Offense Cycle
- Develop Coping Strategies
- Create a safety plan to decrease likelihood of re-offending
- Receive evidence-based therapy for youth's victimization history (if applicable)

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What is a Juvenile Record?

A "juvenile record" is information relating to a juvenile delinquency proceeding. It is the equivalent of a criminal record. If you've been taken into custody by the police you likel juvenile record, which is a permanent record with the State of Texas and the FBI. This appl records, even if your case was dismissed.

What can I do about it?

Isn't my juvenile record automatically sealed?

NO. The law in Texas was recently changed to put a system in place to do sealings for in who are 19 or older, but there is a huge backlog, so most records are NOT automaticall especially in Harris County. To seal a record, an attorney must go into court to file an apt then a judge must grant the application to seal your record.

Could I get my record sealed?

YES. Very likely! Most juvenile records are eligible for sealing. If you are not eligible right I will probably be eligible soon, depending on the kid of offense, how much time has passed s completed probation, and how old you are right now.

What happens when it is sealed?

After an agency receives the court order sealing your record, they have 61 days to follow t and delete your files. After that, the only people who will know you have a juvenile record wi your lawyer, and the court. At that point, in most cases, you are legally allowed to act as if th never happened and say "no" when asked if you have a criminal record.

Juvenile Record Sealing: Why it always matters

Will a juvenile record affect immigration?

YES. Certain adjudications such as drug or sex offenses can derail a legal immigration process. If the child is undocumented, even a single arrest or detainment can jeopardize the child's status

Can a juvenile record affect future court proceeding?

YES. Law enforcement agencies have access to juvenile records unless they are sealed. Juvenile records can be used as evidence for sentencing in certain criminal proceedings and in some civil proceedings.

Is it true that juvenile records begin *before* charges are even filed?

YES. A record begins as soon as detainment. No charges necessary.

Can a juvenile record affect public benefits?

 $\textbf{YES.} \ A \ juvenile \ record, even \ before \ adjudication, can \ affect \ Section \ 8 \ housing, \ Medicaid, \ and \ SSI.$

Can a juvenile record affect college?

 $\begin{tabular}{ll} \bf YES. If an application asks students about an adjudication, students must answer this question in the affirmative UNLESS THEIR RECORD HAS BEEN SEALED. \end{tabular}$

Can a juvenile record affect my employment?

YES. A delinquency adjudication can interfere with jobs related to working with finances, children, vulnerable adults, law enforcement, security, the federal government, or the military, as well as registered licensed, or certified professions and trades.

Can a juvenile record affect my school?

YES. A school can remove children from their regular classes and place them in an alternative program if the child was found guilty of a felony, received a deferred prosecution for a felony, or the principal thinks that the child committed a felony.

Unsuccessful B.A.S.E. Discharges

- Closed B.A.S.E. Referrals: LE submitted referral following the HCDAO's panel decision, however, client never successful started treatment.
- **Discharged B.A.S.E. Referrals:** BASE client began treatment with clinician but was unsuccessfully discharged for various possible reasons.

The PSB Program Coordinator represents all unsuccessful B.A.S.E discharges to the HCDAO panel, whereupon, the panel will make a decision to file charges or drop charges.

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How does our PSB Program Compare?

- PSB-CBT Group Therapy University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center
 - · 2-3 % sexual recidivism rates with PSB treatment
 - YPSB with PSB treatment showed no statistical differences with clinical comparison group
 - 11% sexual recidivism rates for YPSB randomized to play therapy groups (https://connect.ncsby.org/psbcbt/home) (Carpentier, Silovsky & Chaffin, 2006).
 - E DOD)
- Multi-Systemic Therapy-Problem Sexual Behavior (MST-PSB)
 - 99% PSB Free
 - 94% arrest free



- Funding
- · Establishing referral criteria

- · Referral restrictions

- · Client's disclosing other PSB



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Pre-Adjudicated Diversion Program: Benefits

- · Free treatment for YPSB
- Less Trauma (i.e., court, etc.)
- Dr. Lussier himself stated that adjudication itself can be a risk factor for recidivism
- Fighting self-fulfilling prophecy
- Receiving appropriate EBT PSB treatment
- · Clients disclosing other PSB
- Healing from personal victimization (new disclosers)
- Reunification (victim and YPSB receiving services in same locations)
