Cost of Training

\$4,500/per clinician (group model)
\$5,500/per clinician (family model)
\$2,500/per Clinical Supervisor/Senior Leader
*OJJDP grantees cost will be covered under cooperative agreement.



Requirements

Teams consist of at least 2 clinicians (family modality) or 4 clinicians (group modality), clinical supervisor, and 1 Senior Leader.
