

18th Virtual Annual Meeting – Evaluation FAQs

Thank you again for joining us at the NCS Virtual 18th Annual Meeting. Just as NCS had to adapt to these changes, so did the process for claiming your continuing education credits. Along with our partner, Ciné-Med, we've got you covered.

Check out the FAQs below for all the information you'll need to complete your evaluations for live and archived sessions from the meeting:

How do I complete my evaluations, claim CE, and get my certificate for the Virtual Annual Meeting?

Evaluations for the **live** meeting can be found here: <https://cine-med.com/certificates/ncs2020/>. **You will need to create a new username and password on the Ciné-Med site.** This site is not tied to your NCS membership account, so you must create a new login. Please note that the email address you use for this login is where your completed certificate will be sent.

In the live meeting evaluation, you will be able to complete session evaluations just as you have for our past Annual Meetings, including all plenary sessions, poster sessions, and **one** session per concurrent session time slot. You'll then complete the overall evaluation. Your certificate will be emailed to you upon completion of the overall evaluation.

But I watched more than one concurrent session. How do I complete evaluations for those additional sessions?

For all of the remaining sessions, including any archived (recorded) sessions you view, you will need to access the recorded meeting evaluations here: <https://cine-med.com/certificates/ncs2020recorded/>. Similarly to the live meeting site, you will need to create a username and password on the Ciné-Med site. **This site is not tied to your NCS membership account or your live meeting evaluations, so you must create a new login.** Please note that the email address you use for this login is where your completed certificate will be sent.

From there, you can evaluate all the remaining concurrent sessions you've been able to watch for additional CE. Please do **not** re-evaluate/re-claim sessions that were included on your live meeting evaluations. Evaluations will be audited and double claiming of CE is not allowed.

Why so many usernames and passwords? Can't I carry the same one over from site to site?

Unfortunately, not at this time. Due to record keeping and accreditation requirements, the live meeting evaluations and the recorded session evaluations must be separate events with independent credentials. Just as we adapted to this new virtual meeting environment, so did Ciné-Med and its accrediting bodies. We understand this isn't an ideal process, but it does provide all Virtual Annual Meeting attendees with the opportunity to earn more CE than in any other year.
