### THE YEAR IN SUMMARY

NCS had a great year. NCS redefined its brand identity in April and has a fresh and innovative logo. With the website revitalization, we introduced several online communities that provide our 2,500+ multidisciplinary members with an opportunity to hold targeted discussions and share resources. A new subscription-based online resource was launched last summer – Neurocritical Care ON CALL. Featuring over 20 topics, with a new topic introduced each year, it is applicable to physicians, pharmacists, APPs, nurses, and trainees. The content is enriched by a variety of features including videos, monthly webinars, podcasts, tables and figures and more.



The 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting in Boca Raton, Florida was the largest conference in NCS history. With more than 30 learning sessions and workshops, over 50 vendors and 1,082 attendees, NCS is the educational program of choice for neurocritical care professionals. The Emergency Neurological Life Support (ENLS) Certification Program had its widest reach ever with more than 4,500 practitioners earning certification worldwide. We are contributing to neurocritical care research with a training fellowship and clinical study grants. Finally, we have the Neurocritical Care Research Network (NCRN) with registered sites in 47 countries.



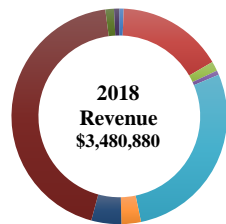
