Mr. Unger was appointed by the United States Attorney General to serve as the Justice Department's Federal Detention Trustee. As a career civil servant with over 26 years of service, Mr. Unger achieved the highest leadership role (Senior Executive Service – Agency Head) before retiring as a Federal Law Enforcement Officer. Additionally, Mr. Unger served as President of the Design-Build Institute of America (DBIA 2003–2004) and is regarded as a leader of the integrated project delivery design-build movement in the public sector. Mr. Unger has an extensive background in various alternative disputes resolution (ADR) techniques, to include Facilitating numerous Partnering Workshops, Mediation Services, and a current member of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transportation Authority Disputes Resolution Board. In 2015, DBIA granted Mr. Unger the Brunelleschi Lifetime Achievement Award, the highest honor DBIA bestows, and he was elevated to “Fellow” as a member of the inaugural Fellowship class by his peers in 2018.
