Brian Bieretz is a policy analyst with the Research to Action Lab at the Urban Institute. Brian works with local governments and other stakeholders to better understand the issues affecting their community and develop evidence-based strategies to tackle those issues. His primary topic area is Pay for Success, a financing tool that allows jurisdictions to use private sector capital to scale programs that service the needs of vulnerable populations and reduce public sector costs. Brian has also developed expertise in early learning policy, urban development issues, and the intersection of housing policy and health. His duties include strategic planning, research translation, training and technical assistance, stakeholder engagement, and data analysis. Previously, Brian worked for Sage Computing, where he wrote about housing and community development issues for the publication Evidence Matters, and for the Maryland Department of Planning. Bieretz received his bachelor's of arts in history from American University and his master's of art in urban planning from the University of Maryland.
