Analyze the Program

- Past & current bidding and political environment
 - Changes to governing board
 - Reduction in number of bids received
 - Voice of the vendor
- Condition of local economy
 - Does your agency have a diverse local vendor base?
 - Has the local economy improved?

Analyze the Program

- Definition of local vendor
 - Is your definition defendable?
 - Requirements represent a "true" local vendor?
- Effectiveness and benefits of the program
 - Does the program by definition benefit the local vendor?
 - Is the program effective and meet the intended goal?

Analyze the Program

- Negative impacts of the program
 - Reduced bidding from non-locals
 - Local vendor definition is not properly defined, verifiable and defendable
- Past award results
 - How many LP awards made?
 - Compare frequency of local, region, state and
 out of state awards

- Opportunity to make a case City's Case
 - Non-local vendor low
 - Local vendor ***BY DEFINITION***
 submitted a Best and Final Price lower than non-local
 - Local vendor
 - Location in Charlotte County with leased office in condo Was not a daily working location
 - Met definition but Council/staff opinion they were not a "true" local vendor

Open door of opportunity!

- Review LP definition and requirements
 - Preference area
 - Type of business
 - Length of time in "local" office
 - "Local" office factors
 - Staffing/equipment



Several agencies adopted LP policies in the downturn of the economy and had insufficient time to prepare a bullet proof program.

- How is the LP factor applied?
 - Award at original price
 - Meet non-local price
 - Meet or beat non-local price
- LP area
 - City, County or Region
- Length of time in LP area



- Type of business
 - Principal Place of Business
 - Satellite/Branch
- Type of Location
 - Commercial or residential
 - Commercial only
 - Principal place of business
 - Storefront or leased condo w/shared
 receptionist

- Local Business Tax requirement
- Staff/employee
 - % of staff assigned to location
 - % of staff reside in preference area
 - Minimum 1 officer/principal reside in preference area
- Equipment and goods stored in preference area

Validation of LP Consideration

- Desktop audit of form
- Desktop audit of form and request additional documentation as necessary
- Desktop audit of form, additional information and OCCASIONAL visit of location
- Desktop audit of form, additional information and visit ALL locations



City's Outcome & Back Up Plan

- 100% support of the City Council to eliminate the LP Policy
- The Mayor relied HEAVILY on NIGP's Resolution 1016
- Quote from Former Mayor "I guess it just made us feel good"
- We did have a back up plan to define a TRUE LOCAL VENDOR in the event the LP Policy was not eliminated

Equipment Requirements	Equipment sufficient to constitute a present ability to perform contract	No requirement



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
